MISSION STATEMENT:

- To join together weekly (in person or in spirit) and bring to God the needs of our parish, our world and all who have asked us to pray for them.

OUR MINISTRY:

- Intercessory prayer is about praying for others. A major part of our commitment is to surround our parish in prayer. We share first names only (or no name) to protect the privacy of those we hold in prayer. There are several ways to join Abide in Me in prayer:

- Come pray with us on Wednesdays from 1-2 pm in the Gathering room in Church
- OR pray each week on your own, with family or a friend
- OR join our weekly email prayer chain: *one email ... many pray-ers.*

WEEKLY FORMAT & SUGGESTED FORMAT FOR PRAYING ON YOUR OWN:

OPENING:

- Center & prepare for prayer
- Song: Return Again (or another song choice)
- Opening Prayer – Thanksgiving and asking the Holy Spirit for guidance
- Scripture reading & pause for silent reflection: **Philippians 4:4-9**
- Faith sharing (as the Spirit leads)

INTERCESSION:

- Song: The Lord's Prayer Worship Song
- Parish Needs
 - Regular intentions
 - Opportunity for spontaneous prayer intentions
 - Silent prayer
- Global – World/Church
 - Regular intentions
 - Opportunity for spontaneous prayer intentions
 - Silent prayer
- Prayer requests
 - Regular intentions
 - Opportunity for spontaneous prayer intentions
 - Silent prayer

CLOSING:

- Reading or reflection
- Song: Everyday God (or another song choice)
- Closing Prayer of Thanksgiving

- For all the troubled areas in the world (name specific countries) ...
- For what other church or world needs shall we pray? (offer spontaneous intentions) ...

Prayer requests - Regular intentions to be prayed for weekly

- For intentions in parish remembrance book, prayer journals & prayer garden pavers, **we pray** ...
- For safety & protection of the most vulnerable among us, especially the unborn, elderly & refugees ...

- For healing grace & peace for those suffering from chronic illness or disability & for their caregivers ...
- For healing for those who are struggling due to all forms of abuse & violence ...
- For all who have turned away from God, do not know Him or have drifted from their faith ...
- For all in need of healing in body, mind or spirit & those who walk with them ...
- For those nearing the end of earthly life, for their loved ones & all who accompany them ...
- For all who have asked for our prayers & those who have no one to pray for them ...
- For all the deceased and comfort for their loved ones ...
