## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

While the summer tends to be a more quiet time in the Religious Education Office, we were happy to be able to bring back our Summer Program this year, which meant that our campus was joyfully busy between June 27 and July 8! About 130 students in grades 1st through 8th joined us this year, and we spent our two weeks exploring our faith in some wonderful ways. We were blessed to be able to attend Mass each day and were grateful to those who regularly attend daily Mass for welcoming us so kindly! Our students loved learning about the Mass through the great teaching Masses offered by Msgr. Rich and Fr. JM. Our children also got to learn more about our church through church tours with Father JM and our visiting seminarian, Tomás Villacis, who also gave some great talks on vocations to our 3rd through 5th and 6th through 8th graders. We also learned some new hymns, thanks to our SJA music teacher, Mr. Peiffer, and by the end of the two weeks, our children were singing with the angels and reminding us that when we sing to God, we are truly praying twice! Our last day of classes ended with a dance party in the gym, courtesy of Fr. JM, who literally kept the children on their toes with his instruction! It was a truly faith-filled, joyful two weeks, and we are so very grateful to the amazing catechists and aides who were the reason we could offer this special option! As we enter into August, we are also looking to the fall, as we continue to prepare for our traditional weekly program and other faith formation opportunities we will offer all of our families. 

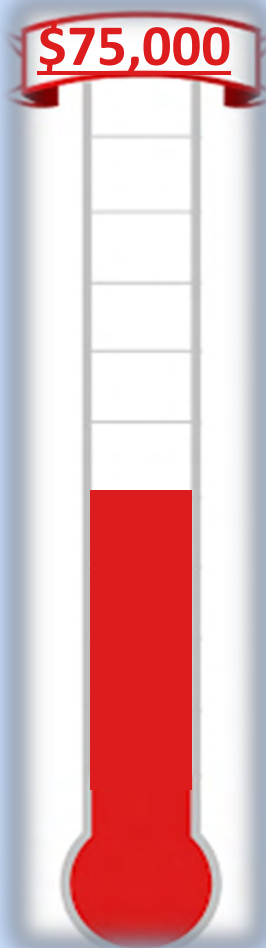

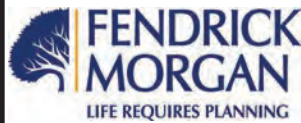
