



GETTING JESUS

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Out of his mind. Possessed. Hard for us to imagine anyone thinking this way about Jesus. But people did, according to Mark's Gospel. Even members of his own family found him hard to take, a bit of an embarrassment. Read 3:20-35.

Many people back then didn't "get" Jesus. Many people today don't either, but perhaps for different reasons. Back then, people found him a bit too "new," too radical. He "broke" sabbath rules. He put people first (especially the "undesirables"). Today, many people find Jesus too conventional, too status-quo, all wrapped up with the "in crowd." Back then, Jesus got accused of being too familiar with sinners, too inclusive. Today, Jesus is viewed by many as judgmental and divisive. Interesting turn of events, don't you think? How did that happen?

Many people today believe in God. Even people who no longer attend church or pray or even think much about God, still might believe in God. In a way, it's easy to believe in God or a "divine spark" or "life-force" inside of us. Such belief doesn't make many demands.

But Jesus. Jesus is hard. It's harder to "get" him. Jesus is flesh and blood. Jesus may be too real for folks, to close for comfort. Jesus cried. Jesus bled. Jesus touched the sores on people's skin. Jesus made people feel uncomfortable. They wanted "to seize him," hide him, shut him up. When he said things like, "I am the bread of life," people started walking away. When he said forgive seventy seven times, people thought it impossible.

I wonder if over the years we have polished up Jesus a bit too much. Have we smoothed away his "edge"? Made him more of a decal than God's Word in the flesh?

We are reading Mark's Gospel. Lot of "rough edges" in Mark. Not the most polished gospel. It sort of puts Jesus in our face. Not a bad thing to do now and again. When He's in our face, we get to see Jesus for who he really is and not who we want him to be.

Life can be very hectic and as a Parish we are trying to make your child's religious education a little more manageable. Therefore, we offer several programs.

Traditional Program:

- Monday or Tuesday afternoons and evenings
- Classes for Grades 1-5 from 4-5:15pm, Grades 6-8 from 7-8:15pm
- Maximum of 2 absences permitted.

Home Study Program:

- Offered for grades 3-6
- You teach your child at home one lesson using the provided program.
- Signed chapter tests are submitted to the Religious Education Office.
- You and your child are required to attend 3 activities throughout the year.

Special Disciples: Each child learns in a different method. For those students who need to have one on one attention or have a special need, we offer a class every other Sunday morning during the 9am Mass. We have certified Special Needs Catechists who work with your child.

Family Catechesis:

- 2nd grade parents only
- You teach your child at home for 3 weeks using a provided curriculum.
- You and your child attend a class once a month in the evening to reinforce what was taught at home.
 Summer Intensive: program is full & registration is closed.
