

GOSPEL MATTHEW 24:37-44

Jesus said to his disciples: "As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. In those days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day that Noah entered the ark. They did not know until the flood came and carried them all away. So will it be also at the coming of the Son of Man. Two men will be out in the field; one will be taken, and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken, and one will be left. Therefore, stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come. Be sure of this: if the master of the house had known the hour of night when the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and not let his house be broken into. So too, you also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come."

GET UP AND GO



Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Advent is a journey. Advent wants to take us to a new place. Advent invites us to climb a mountain, go into a desert, walk in circles, get lost, find a new home. In other words, Advent — actually, God — wants to take us to a new place. To find Christ in new ways — in the Scriptures, yes. In prayer, yes. Deep within our hearts, yes. Deeper into our relationships, yes. But also to find Christ in unexpected ways.

Like the Magi who left home and all that is familiar to follow a star, to find Christ, my prayer is that each of us will let these weeks of Advent move us in new and uncharted directions ... in prayer, in service, in charity, in mercy, in recovery, in our relationships, in new relationships.

To take the journey, Advent must untether us, unwind us, maybe even unhinge us a bit. It's risky, yes. But this is how we find the peace and joy and the fullness of life that Jesus wants to give us.

In this journey, Advent also wants to show us a new world — the world as God sees it, the world as God hopes it will be.

Our parish theme this Advent is Led By A Star. May we all be in a new place when Christmas comes, when the Christ-Child comes. We do not journey alone. We journey together as a community. We journey with Christ.

So, finally, let me urge you not to do Advent alone. Walk it with your family and friends. Have conversations about Christ, about the meaning of the Sunday readings and Christmas, at your dinner tables (at home and even in Chic-fil-a!). Talk about faith in the car waiting in traffic or while standing in shopping lines. Just say: "Where has God been taking you lately?"

Join a Small Group here in our parish. Come to Mass, one Sunday at a time. Light the Advent candles at dinner. Say a prayer after you decorate the tree. Pray wrapping presents. Sing a lot and out loud. Come to our Christmas Carol Festival. Bring peace wherever you go. Be open to surprises. Allow God to teach you new things.

Advent is a journey.
