

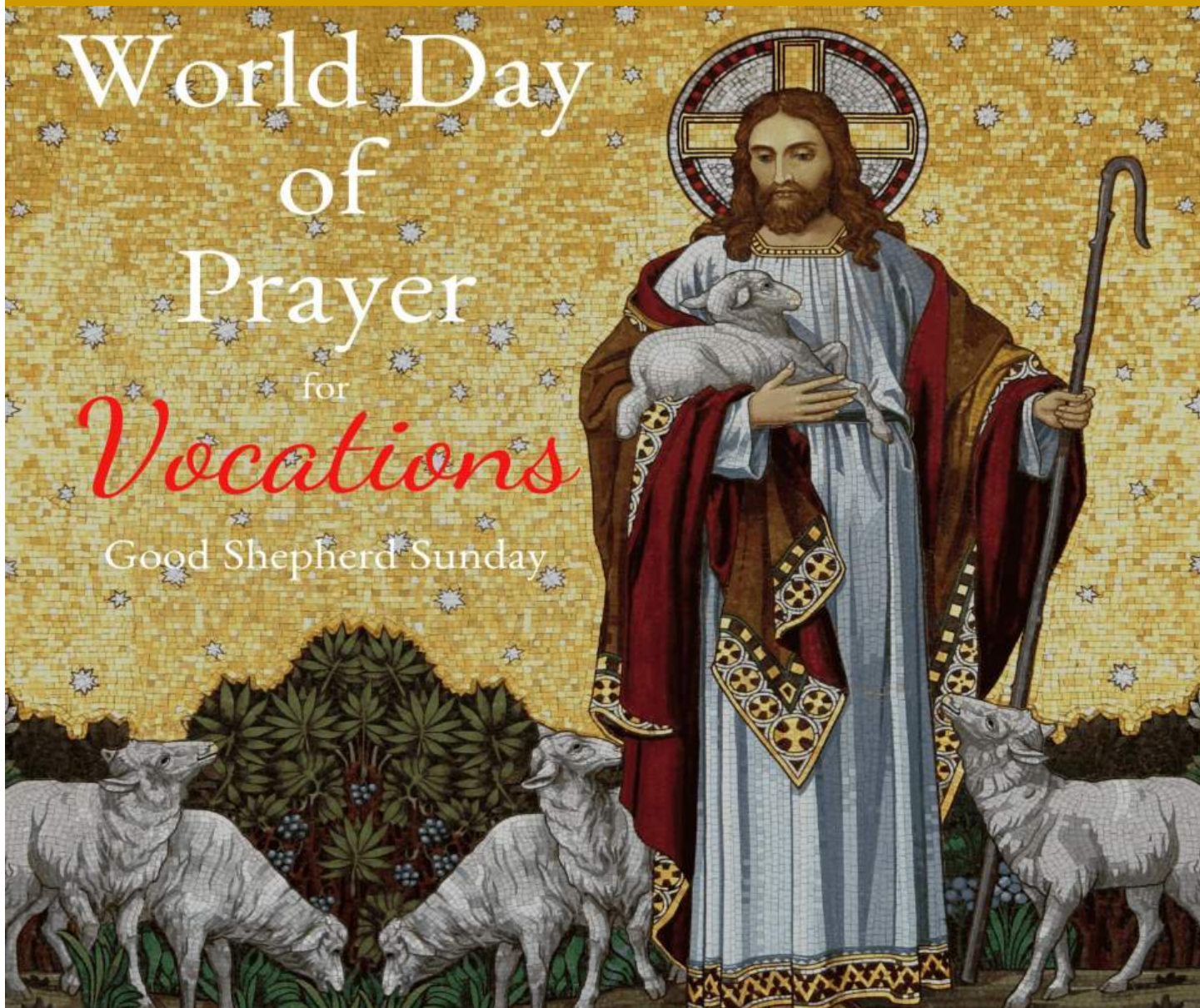

GOSPEL

Jn 10: 1-10

Jesus said: "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber. But whoever enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens it for him, and the sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.

When he has driven out all his own, he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice. But they will not follow a stranger; they will run away from him, because they do not recognize the voice of strangers." Although Jesus used this figure of speech, the Pharisees did not realize what he was trying to tell them.

So Jesus said again, "Amen, amen, I say to you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep did not listen to them. I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. A thief comes only to steal and slaughter and destroy; I came so that they might have life and have it more abundantly."

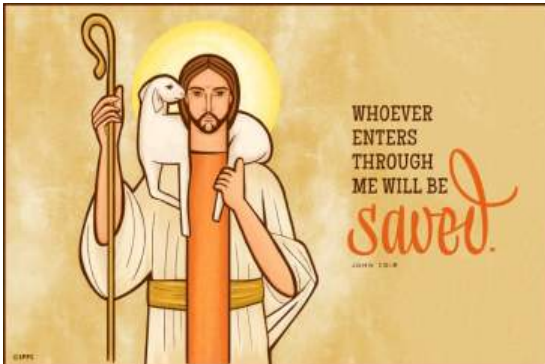

They truly welcome our Lord and I see the face of God in them all. Truly I feel closer to Jesus and have come to care very deeply for all these Angel's. I just love them ALL!"

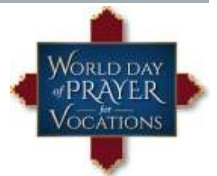

Helpers are volunteers who "walk with" pregnant women and their families in order to ease their life burdens with support services to give them hope. Last year we had 58 clients and 44 babies were born into "our family". So far, in 2023, we have 19 new clients and 21 babies have been born. 2 of these babies' mothers were at the Cherry Hill Women's Center for abortion appointments but changed their minds at the last minute and spoke to 40 Days for Life prayer volunteers outside on the sidewalk. Praise be to God! Others were referred by friends, social service agencies, pregnancy care centers, hospitals and various other ways the Holy Spirit guided them to us. We rely on private donors and receive no government grants or assistance. Please help us to continue to enable brave mothers to reject abortion and choose life! Checks can be made out to Helpers NJ. In addition we would be happy to receive Walmart gift cards. These allow our mothers to buy food, clothing or whatever they may need for their families. Arrive in Crisfield, MD and enjoy a little free time before we board the boat to Smith Island. This small quaint town is known as the "Crabmeat Capitol of the World". Next we will board the Chelsea Lane Tyler for a narrated tour to Smith Island, Maryland's only inhabited Chesapeake Bay Island with fewer than 300 people. Residents are direct descendants of English Settlers. Upon debarking the ship, we will proceed to the Bayside Inn for a traditional family style meal consisting a crab cake, clam fritters, ham, salad, delicious sides and non alcoholic drinks. The special treat of the day Smith Island Cake. This delicacy consists of 9-12 layers and has been baked since 1800 by local women. Come prepared with a cooler for local purchases. 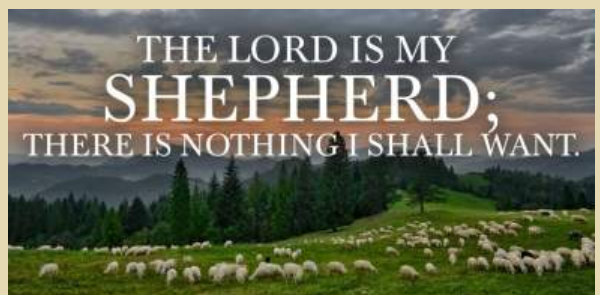

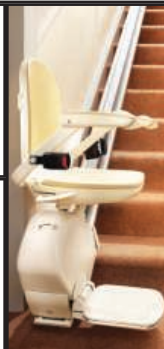
