GOSPEL

Jn 6: 51-58

Jesus said to the Jewish crowds:

"I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

The Jews quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever."

FAITH SHARING QUESTIONS

Do you come to communion "out of habit" or are you truly coming seeking Jesus wholeheartedly?

How might the Eucharist serve as an invitation to connect closer with another person and God at the same time? Think on this.

BRINGING BACK "THE CUP"

Upon the recommendation of our Parish Liturgy Team, and with the approval of Bishop O'Connell, **beginning this weekend, we will once again offer Holy Communion under both species, consecrated bread and wine — the Body and Blood of Christ — at each Sunday Mass!** This is especially beautiful and most appropriate because today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. Today also marks the beginning of the parish phase of the **Eucharistic Revival** our American Bishops called for last year.

Because we have not shared the Communion Cup in quite some time, due to COVID, those who wish to receive are reminded to carefully receive the Cup from the Eucharistic Minister and take a small sip, returning the Cup to the Minister, who will reverently wipe the rim of the Cup with a purificator. Please remember that intinction (dipping the Consecrated Host) is not permitted.

As before, receiving the Precious Blood is an option. It is not required. Obviously, those who are feeling ill in any way, should not partake of the Cup (actually, if we are feeling ill, the loving thing to do, as we have learned these past few years, is to remain home joining us via livestream until feeling better).

"The Eucharist In Action"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

If you Google images of "Eucharist," nearly all that appear will be closeups of the elements, bread and wine, reverently held in the hands of a priest (or Pope) or housed in a monstrance for adoration. Only 3 images of the first 100 to appear on my screen included people participating at Mass (like this one).



We don't usually think of the Eucharist in terms of "action." Like Google, we think primarily of the Eucharistic elements rather than of the Eucharistic relationships made and strengthened by the bread and wine that becomes the Body and Blood of Christ.

In the Eucharist we are united to God *and* to one another. In the Eucharist our eyes are opened to the real presence of Christ among us, feeding and nourishing us with His body and blood so that we can offer our lives in loving service to God and each other. This is the Eucharistic Action.

Many years ago we used to speak more often of a "Eucharistic people." I don't hear the phrase as much anymore, but this is indeed what we are and what we are called to do: to be Eucharist for one another, to be the presence of Christ (His mercy and compassion) especially to those who are hurting, to welcome and include all at the table, as Christ did.

It is perfectly fine and right to consider how the bread and wine become Christ's Body and Blood. But it is equally as important, dare I say even more so, to live, to embody, to share the Real Presence of Christ that we adore and receive in the Eucharist.

This action begins at Sunday Mass.

As we enter a new phase of the national Eucharistic Revival, I challenge all of us to make Mass a priority, to rearrange our schedules if we must to be here. And more: I challenge us not just to show up on Sunday, but also to be truly present to the people gathered, to the Word of God, to the Sacrament we celebrate. Even more: I challenge us to invite those who no longer come to Mass to give it another try.

Let's make it a very active Eucharistic Revival!

ADULT FAITH FORMATION

This weeks Eucharistic Revival testimony is written by Deacon Gene Kotowski.

"During a discussion in our Lenten small group, I shared my thoughts on this statement posed by our group leaders:

Share a time when you felt Mass was a "holy meal" for you. There were two occasions when I felt Mass was a "holy meal"...

I never experienced Holy Week growing up. It wasn't until Fr. Rich became our pastor that I decided to take off from work on Good Friday. For the first time in my life I was able to truly experience the Holy Triduum. Fr. Rich mentioned, that first year, something called a Paschal Fast.

I know what that is now, but back then I thought it meant to fast for those three days. And that's exactly what I did.

I stopped eating and drinking everything at midnight on Holy Thursday and would not nourish my body again until Easter Sunday.

And to think I did that for two years in a row.

What an experience that was. I realized the pain I was feeling could never compare to the pain that Jesus went through for me.

The Eucharist was the only meal I'd eat on Holy Thursday, Good Friday & Easter Sunday.....but it was a meal that satisfied the needs of my body & soul. Those three days of fasting were life changing. They definitely changed how I felt about the Eucharist. I have a greater appreciation of the holy meal.

The second occasion was not too long along. In 2018, a group of parishioners from SJA took a weekend trip to the Benedictine Priory in Weston, VT. It was Palm Sunday weekend.

When it came time to celebrate Mass with the Brothers, I experienced something like never before. After the celebrant consecrated the bread & wine, he made his way around the altar to the other Brothers, allowing them to partake of the Body of Christ. Then he made his way to those gathered, allowing us to partake of His body too.

I felt at that moment that I was in the presence of Jesus at the Last Supper.

His body, in that piece of bread, satisfied all of my needs. That whole experience brought about a wave of emotions that lead to an overflowing of tears. Now as a deacon, I get to experience Jesus in a wonderfully new light and treasure every time I'm able to receive Eucharist. And I feel so blessed to be able to minister Jesus, in the Eucharist, to family, friends, strangers and acquaintances."

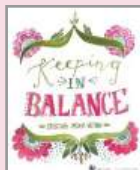

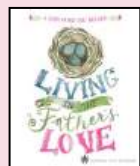

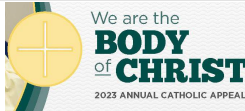
