GOSPEL

Matthew 9: 36-10:8

At the sight of the crowds, Jesus' heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest."

Then he summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits to drive them out and to cure every disease and every illness. The names of the twelve apostles are these: first, Simon called Peter, and his brother Andrew; James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James, the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddeus; Simon from Cana, and Judas Iscariot who betrayed him.

Jesus sent out these twelve after instructing them thus, "Do not go into pagan territory or enter a Samaritan town. Go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. As you go, make this proclamation: 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons. Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give."

"History of Faces"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I imagine there will be a lot of photos taken today wherever people gather with their dads. It's just a natural thing to do when people get together ... take a pic! We all have thousands upon thousands of these pics on our phones.

For those whose dads may be deceased, this weekend will no doubt stir up many memories ... as well as a few old photos taken when dad was here. Take a look at that picture on your phone or the one framed sitting on your dresser.

Pictures help us remember and honor.

Coincidentally, in today's Scripture readings at Mass (which were chosen for the 11th Sunday of Ordinary Time, not for Father's Day), we hear the names of a lot of fathers of our faith: Moses and Jacob in Exodus, and in Matthew's Gospel the names of the original 12 apostles called by Jesus. We don't have any paintings of these men. Surely, through the years after they lived, plenty of artists have tried to create a likeness of them on canvas or in stone. Each one of them had a real face with skin and eyes and a nose and ears and hair (a lot or not so much), perhaps scars and lines and marks and wrinkles.

History books are filled with names. Each name was a living person with a face that laughed and cried. This history of our faith is the same.

While we must never forget that women have played a vital role (and still do!) in handing down our faith in Christ, this Father's Day is a good day to remember all the men who sacrificed much, trusted God, and worked incredibly hard to build a tangible community of faith ... not just a spiritual church, but a church with flesh and blood and the faces of countless believers.
