## "GOT ANXIETY?"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Anyone dealing with anxiety issues will find a friend in Jeremiah. "Terror on every side!" Jeremiah shouts in this Sunday's First Reading from the Bible.

Who doesn't feel at least a little bit anxious these days? If you're only a "little bit" anxious, good for you. Polls and surveys suggest there are a lot of people — of every age, even children — experiencing a lot of anxiety. Social media, we are told, is exasperating the problem.

The Good News is that we also have a Gospel this Sunday that begins, "Fear no one!" The Good News is that there is an antidote to fear and anxiety. That antidote is a relationship with Jesus Christ. Yes, faith helps. Faith moves us from fear to a deep, abiding trust in a God who knows you and loves you. Faith gives perspective, inner strength, wisdom, and serenity.

It is no accident that what is known as the Serenity Prayer comes from the pen of a person of faith, a Christian theologian. Here is the prayer in it's entirety:

"God grant me the serenity to accept the things I can not change, courage to change the things I can, and the wisdom to know the difference, living one day at a time; enjoying one moment at a time; taking this world as it is and not as I would have it; trusting that You will make all things right if I surrender to Your will; so that I may be reasonably happy in this life and supremely happy with You forever in the next." Amen.

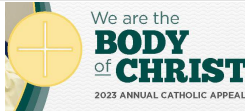
