MASS WITH THE LGBTQ COMMUNITY

In joyful thanksgiving to Almighty God, the creator of all human life, our **One in the Spirit Prayer Group** invites members of the LGBTQ Community, their family and friends, as well as all SJA parishioners, to join us for **Mass on Thursday, June 15th at 7:30pm**, followed by a Lite Reception in the Arc Room in the Parish Center. As Roman Catholics, we value and treasure the great gift of the Eucharist, the real presence of Christ, who nourishes and strengthens all of us to love as God loves. Let us come together to celebrate, proclaim and share God's amazing love with everyone, no exceptions!

BRINGING BACK "THE CUP"

Upon the recommendation of our Parish Liturgy Team, and with the approval of Bishop O'Connell, Fathers Rich and JM have decided that **beginning next Sunday, we will once again offer Holy Communion under both species, consecrated bread and wine — the Body and Blood of Christ — at each Sunday Mass!** This is especially beautiful and most appropriate because next Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. It also marks the beginning of the parish phase of the **Eucharistic Revival** our American Bishops called for last year.

Because we have not shared the Communion Cup in quite some time, due to COVID, those who wish to receive are reminded to carefully receive the Cup from the Eucharistic Minister and take a small sip, returning the Cup to the Minister, who will reverently wipe the rim of the Cup with a purificator. Please remember that intinction (dipping the Consecrated Host) is not permitted.

As before, receiving the Precious Blood is an option. It is not required. Obviously, those who are feeling ill in any way, should not partake of the Cup (actually, if we are feeling ill, the loving thing to do, as we have learned these past few years, is to remain home joining us via livestream until feeling better.)

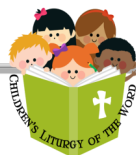

ADULT FAITH FORMATION

This weeks Eucharistic Revival testimony is written by Joanne Swift MD.

"I have been a member of SJA since birth and received all of my sacraments here. I have been a Eucharistic Minister since 2018....

Even as a very small child in Mass, I knew when I heard the bells ring, saw the Host elevated, and my mother bowed her head and struck her chest, that something very Sacred was happening.

I remember seeing my older brother at his First Holy Communion putting his head in his hands, and I asked my mother why people did that. She said, "So they don't lose Jesus."

This gift of the Catholic Faith, first given to my brothers and me by our mother, and the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist were most indelibly etched into my memory when I watched my mom grab my dad's hand as my brother Dan began the Consecration at his First Mass.

When Sister Peg asked me if I had ever thought of being an EM, I answered, "Yes, many times. It would be the privilege of my life." When she wondered why I had not volunteered, I responded that it didn't seem to be the sort of "activity" one "signed up" for. It just seemed too special, and that if God willed it, one day maybe it would happen.

Now, as an EM, every time I am handed that ciborium, and I look down at Jesus Christ Himself, I feel so unworthy, yet so honored. Many recipients are my patients, and I know their struggles and their heartaches. To be able to cross that often-forbidden bridge from practicing medicine to practicing my faith has indeed been the privilege of my life." - Joanne Swift MD
