# EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL

This weeks Eucharistic Revival testimony is written by Cathy Amico.

"I remember how I felt that special day in my white dress, veil and white shoes on my First Holy Communion to receive Jesus for the very first time. I had to remember to keep my hands folded together, pointed up towards heaven and to keep my eyes down while having to remember never to have the host touch my teeth. I was seven years old.

So as a youngster, I was receiving Jesus each week. As a teenager attending mass, something was starting to happen especially during the consecration as the priest would hold up the Eucharist while the bells would ring. Tears would fill my eyes as I would say within my heart, Jesus I love you.

At that time, did I have a relationship with Jesus? No, not really. Was I reading scripture daily? No not really. I was just going through life and trying to figure out who I am and what am I going to do with my life.

As a young woman I married and a year later we had our first born, our daughter. Then our second year, we had a son. But this pregnancy was a rough one and I had to stay in the hospital for some time before being sent home. I was 22 years old with two small children and our home which needed a lot of fixing up.

Two years later I was expecting our third child. When my husband and I went for my first visit, the doctor called us in his office to suggest I not go through with this pregnancy. He advised that I terminate it asap. In his words, chances of my surviving through another pregnancy would be very slim.

Hearing those words in his office left me feeling numb. I was 23 years old with two small children at home. The doctor said to go home and think about this and call me to let me know what your decision is. I can remember the drive home was very quiet. As a few days had passed, my husband, Tony, shared his great concern about having two small kids and having to work. If something did happen to me what would he and the kids do? I totally understood everything he said at that time and could not disagree with him on anything he said. It was all so very real. But I looked in his eyes and said, "Tony, I cannot have them take our baby. I will be ok." I suggested we call a priest.

We were living here in this parish and the priest was on our doorstep within the hour. He prayed with us and then gave us the name of a doctor and said, "I know he has dealt with something very similar to your case. If you need to, please call this doctor."

I asked Tony to trust, along with me, that this child within me would be born and that I would be fine. Down the road, I called that doctor as I was taken into the hospital.

I was in his care for the next nine months at which time our son Michael was born weighing 8lbs 12oz. The doctor's voice has remained with me because of him saying, when he held Michael up after delivering him, "Here is your son."

Michael eventually became good friends with both the priest and the doctor. In fact, the priest officiated at Michael's wedding, and the doctor came to Michael's wedding.

The picture and story was on the cover of our Monitor newspaper...a day full of great joy!

This is but one of many stories throughout my life that knowing the presence of Jesus through his body and blood in the Eucharist and through his word and through prayer, have been my source of faith and belief that God's spirit truly lives within...we need only to believe and act on it."
