"Declaring Our Faith"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

I know many scholars and non-scholars alike argue and debate about the faith and religious practices of the signers of the Declaration of Independence. And surely, these many years later, we can acknowledge the apparent hypocrisy of slave-owners writing and signing their name to a document that acknowledges, "all men are created equal." However imperfect these signers were, it is just as certain that — because there it is in print — that the basis of their argument for freedom was the "self-evident truth" that all people "are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness."

We have been dogged as a nation from our beginning to live and practice what we say is a self-evident truth. Not many years after the Declaration, we adopted our Constitution which allowed states to keep slavery legal. Yet in that same Constitution, the founders painstakingly and very purposefully did not use the word slavery and did not refer to slaves as property. They referred to them as "persons." Picking up on this, President Abraham Lincoln, less than a hundred years later, during the terrible Civil War, in his Emancipation Proclamation, purposely wrote, "all persons held as slaves ... shall be then, thenceforward, and forever free ..."

President Lincoln could have simply written, "all slaves" are free. Instead, he purposefully recognized those held in bondage as "persons."

These works mentioned above are not religious documents, but even so they acknowledge something we firmly believe as Roman Catholic Christians: that all people are created by God, and, in our language, in God's image; that no one, *ever*, should be treated as less than a human person. This belief is the bedrock, the foundation of *all* our Christian morality and ethics, as well as our Catholic Social Teaching.

All human life comes from God.

No one should ever belittle, degrade or destroy it.

In defending this belief, may we be as trusting in "divine Providence" and as passionate and firm in our resolve as our founders were when they risked everything, their lives, their fortunes, their sacred honor, to forge this nation. We, after all, are building something even bigger. The Kingdom of God.

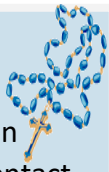

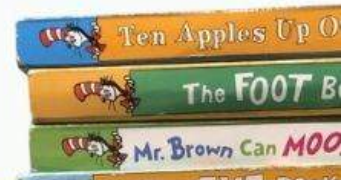
