Opening Day for students in grades 5-8 is Thursday, September 7th; grades K-4 start Friday, September 8th. Both days are 12:30 dismissal. Kindergarten parents are welcome to meet in Pedata Hall on Friday morning after student drop-off (Beginning at 8:00AM) for refreshments and to see kindergarten students connect with their teachers. 
