

"JESUS IS HERE"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We are off and rolling! School has begun. Meetings and prayer groups and Bible studies are starting. Though we are in the ninth month, it really is like a new year is beginning. All new beginnings are filled with great anticipation and high hopes. My one really high hope is that our church building will be full of people — of every age — on every Sunday at every Mass.

If you know someone who has been away from Mass, or someone who hasn't gotten back since March of 2020 when COVID hit, why not invite them to come with you? It doesn't have to be a high pressure sell — in fact, it shouldn't be. It should be a joyful, gentle invitation.

You have heard that this is the year of Eucharistic Revival. The hope and goal of the Revival is that all of us renew and deepen our love for this great Sacrament of Christ's real presence. Why is this important? Quite simply, because this is the gift Jesus Christ gave us the night before He died. This is the way Jesus chose to be remembered and the way He chose to be with us, nourishing us, strengthening us so that we as His disciples can love the way He loves.

In today's Gospel, Jesus assures us that when two or three are gathered together in His name that He is there among us. This is not just a spiritual presence. Christ's presence is embodied in this gathering, in His Church. He is REALLY present when we gather in His name, when we pray, when we hear His Word, and when we receive His Body and Blood.

So, you see, the Eucharist is our food for the journey together. In the Eucharist we become what we consume. The Eucharist is our bridge to unity with God and with each other.

This is how Jesus chose to be remembered. This is how Christ chose to be present to and with us. This is how Christ helps us be present to and with Him and one another.

This is why it is so important.

Jesus said to his disciples: "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother. If he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, so that 'every fact may be established on the testimony of two or three witnesses.' If he refuses to listen to them, tell the church. If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector. Amen, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again, amen, I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."




