GOSPEL

Mt 20: 1-16

Jesus told his disciples this parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out at dawn to hire laborers for his vineyard. After agreeing with them for the usual daily wage, he sent them into his vineyard. Going out about nine o'clock, the landowner saw others standing idle in the marketplace, and he said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard, and I will give you what is just.' So they went off. And he went out again around noon, and around three o'clock, and did likewise. Going out about five o'clock, the landowner found others standing around, and said to them, 'Why do you stand here idle all day?' They answered, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You too go into my vineyard.' When it was evening the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Summon the laborers and give them their pay, beginning with the last and ending with the first.' When those who had started about five o'clock came, each received the usual daily wage. So when the first came, they thought that they would receive more, but each of them also got the usual wage. And on receiving it they grumbled against the landowner, saying, 'These last ones worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us, who bore the day's burden and the heat.' He said to one of them in reply, 'My friend, I am not cheating you. Did you not agree with me for the usual daily wage? Take what is yours and go. What if I wish to give this last one the same as you? Or am I not free to do as I wish with my own money? Are you envious because I am generous?' Thus, the last will be first, and the first will be last."

JESUS AND THE ECONOMY?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Clearly, Jesus did not attend the Wharton School of Business! Listen to the parable told in today's Gospel of Matthew (20:1-16a), and you will see Jesus would have failed Business 101.

So, here's a trick: we should not read this parable, or any of Jesus' parables, looking for good business practices or good economic policy. If after any of Jesus' parables we say, "well, that just isn't realistic," we have missed the point. And it's a big point. Too big to miss.

In fact, if we miss the point of the parables, we miss it to our own peril and detriment.

In the parables, Jesus is talking about the Kingdom of God, the presence of God. Jesus is talking about how God relates to us and to all of creation.

I strongly suggest disregarding the traditional titles given to the parables ... they are usually misleading and sometimes even wrong. Today's has traditionally been called the Parable of the Workers in the Vineyard. I think it is both misleading and wrong.

Look for the surprise in every parable. That will tell you something really important about God and God's Kingdom. There is a very big surprise in today's Gospel ... and it may not be the one you see immediately. You may have to read it a couple of times. It's always good to come to Mass to hear it proclaimed in a voice that is not your own. You might have to do some work, some digging, some wrestling with the text. Try to hear it fresh, as if for the first time.

Parables are meant to wake us up and meet God ... and therefore ourselves ... in a new way. This is how they spoke to people who first heard Jesus

Go ahead, let Jesus make your day. And your life.
