## Jesus Makes It Interesting

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Some might say this is where Jesus complicates things, but I think this is where He makes things very interesting.

Which is the greatest law? That's the question posed to Jesus (Mt. 22:34-40). It's a reasonable request. There were hundreds of laws a good Jew was expected to follow. So, what's number one? Love God with everything you've got, Jesus replies, "with all your heart, soul and mind." Then Jesus goes one step further. Because it is like it, He says, "Love your neighbor as yourself."

There. Right *there* it gets interesting.

Following Jesus is not only a vertical affair. Loving God is not just a "me and my Lord" experience. Loving God is not something that happens only in church, not something that ignores others or the condition of the world. Loving God is not just a spiritual thing.

Jesus' response has given mystics and theologians much to reflect on over the centuries. One of them, Fr. Ronald Rolheiser (some of you are now reading a wonderful book of his on the Eucharist), pulls from Jesus' answer four non-negotiables in Christian living:

- (1) Private Prayer and Private Morality;
- (2) Social Justice;
- (3) Mellowness of Heart and Spirit  
(a spirit of gratitude and compassion);
- (4) Community as a Constitutive Element of True Worship.

These four pillars of spirituality bring fullness and balance to our discipleship. Likewise, when one or more of these elements is missing, there is an imbalance in our response to God's presence in our lives. According to Father Rolheiser ... and, I'm inclined to believe, according to Jesus.

Jesus never says He is going to make following Him easy. Just life-changing and life-giving. And not only for us who follow Him.

Let's Walk Together!

We can all use a revival every now and then. A jumpstart. A good kick in the pants, so to speak (to speak rather brashly). # SYNOD NOTES



## HOW MANY TIMES HAVE YOU SAID IT?

We've been hearing people use the "S" word a little more often. Admittedly, for most of us, we have never used the word "synod" in a conversation. There still may be many reading this who have yet to say the word aloud themselves. If that's the case with you, give it a shot: synod, pronounced "sin-odd".

Some interesting observations about its pronunciation. First, the second syllable: odd. Many may think it is an odd word. Though it is new to us, it is not new to the Church. Synods have been around for centuries. Some may remember our own Diocese of Trenton held a Diocesan Synod in 1990. It was the **4th** Synod in our Diocesan history.

The first syllable sounds like our English word "sin." But "syn," with a "y," in the original Greek (the language from which we get the word synod) means: "together." So, "syn" and "sin" may sound alike but in reality there are direct opposites. Sin, with an "i", pulls apart, separates, divides. Sin ruptures relationships. Sin comes from thinking only of myself and what I want. Whereas "syn," as in synod, means journeying together, discerning God's will together, sharing and listening in mutual trust and care, being open to Christ, the Gospel, and the direction of the Holy Spirit.

In this way, the current Synod has much in common with the Eucharist. The Eucharist teaches us to walk together with Christ and one another, to be really present to each other, to be united to all of God's people inside and outside of the church building.

There's another Greek word for you! When was the last time you said **EUCCHARIST**?

**This past week, Synod participants reflected on the theme: "Participation, Governance and Authority."**

**Members discussed how we can build a synodal Church that empowers the co-responsible participation of all the baptized.**

**Part One of this Synod of Bishops comes to a conclusion today, Sunday, the 29th of October. A draft document will be produced and the Synod will continue in October of 2024.**

**Please pray for our parish that we will grow together as a synodal community of faith.**

**A synodal parish needs the full participation of all of us.**

**In prayer, ask the Holy Spirit to help you discern your gifts and how you can help our parish fulfill its mission to "celebrate, proclaim and share God's love with everyone ... no exceptions."**

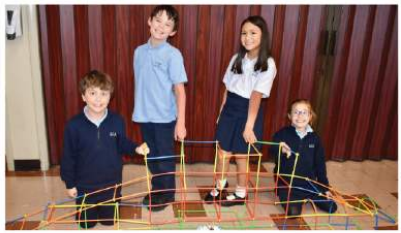

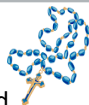

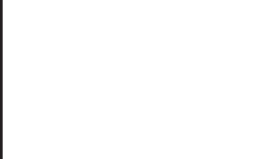
