Mt 25: 14-15, 19-21

33rd SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME/2023

MATTHEW 25

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We are in the middle of the 25th chapter of St. Matthew's Gospel. The chapter is unique because it consists of 3 (kind of long) stories, two of which are parables and the last more like a vision. The stories involve virgins at a wedding feast (last Sunday's Gospel), servants turned investors (this Sunday) and, lastly, sheep and goats (next Sunday). There is no exposition at all in this chapter, just a brief introduction by Jesus: "The Kingdom of Heaven will be like ..."

All three involve an accounting, of sorts, not in terms of finances (although this Sunday's parables involve money), but in terms of discipleship and the choices we make as disciples. In all three stories, some of the players make wise choices, fruitful choices, selfless choices. Others in the parables make choices of the opposite kind: foolish, fearful and selfish.

I know there is a lot going on this week ... Thanksgiving! God bless all of you who give so much and work so hard to make this day of thankfulness a special event for family and friends. Frs. JM, Richard and I will be sharing a Thanksgiving meal this Tuesday with the Sisters of St. Joseph — an annual experience that we have come to look forward to. Many of our parishioners have been working hard to prepare a meal for those in our community who will be alone this Thanksgiving. All of you here, and in your own homes, who plan and prepare Thanksgiving dinner are, in my opinion, great examples of faithful discipleship that Jesus describes in Matthew 25. We see in real time what the Kingdom of Heaven is like.

If you have time (and many of you won't, I understand), it would be worth reading the entirety of Matthew 25. Not only will it be a great preparation to next Sunday's Mass, but also to Advent which is quickly approaching. It might also add another dimension to the Thanksgiving Feast.

With a grateful heart for all you do for the Kingdom of God!
