THINK CLAY

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This Advent will be over in a blink of an eye ... so we must do everything we can to slow it down and pay attention. Our first reading today from Isaiah gives us a helpful hint on how to do this.

Think pottery.

Well, clay. Think clay. Clay in the hand of a potter. It must have been a powerful image in ancient Israel. Jeremiah uses it, too. We are the clay. God, the potter. We are the work of His hands.

How and in what ways will God form you this Advent? What rough edges will be smoothed over? What emptiness will be filled? What new design will be inscribed on your heart, your face?

It takes patience to form the clay. You. Me. Us. And how it begins may not be how it finishes. There may be several attempts.

Let God's Word form you this Advent. Let God's Word fashion your mood and attitude and disposition as you wait in lines or traffic, clean the house, put up the tree, work in the kitchen, work at your work, visit.

Let the Eucharist, the Body of Christ, form your body, how you use your hands, where your feet take you. Let the presence of Christ in the Eucharist wake you up and help you be present to the moment and pay attention to what is said and not said.

Be mold-able, this Advent. Where you are fixed and immovable (aka: stubborn), let God's grace work its way in. Where you are stuck (i.e. complacent or lazy or going in circles), let God's grace motivate and energize you.

God is the potter. We are the clay. Let God have a go at you. See what God can make of you.

Happy Adventing!

Four times in the gospel, Jesus commands us, "Be watchful!" or "Watch!" We are the servants left in charge, and we are the ones who watch and wait for our master, our Lord's return.

What is the most exciting thing to you about Jesus' Second Coming? The most distressing? What questions would you like to ask Jesus about it?

Why do you think the Lord keeps secret the exact time of his Second Coming? What would be the advantages of knowing? The disadvantages?

And while we are called to watch for Jesus' Second Coming, we also need to watch for Jesus' coming *now* in our everyday lives.

When do I find myself truly alert to Jesus' presence from the time I wake in the morning until the time I sleep at night? What helps me recognize Jesus's presence in every day encounters?

ADVENTING ...

Everything we are learning this year about the Eucharist and the Synod points to our journeying together, paying deeper attention to one another and being present to those who are hurting. So, let's do Advent together! We hope this Advent Calendar will help all of us prepare for Christmas and the coming of the Lord! (Pay Attention: the dates are purposely scrambled to keep us on our toes ... the way Advent wants prepare us, on our toes, up and alert and ready to meet Jesus!

SUNDAY, DECEMBER 3

As we begin this journey together, lighting the first candle on our Advent Wreath, we pray, "Come, Lord Jesus, come!" This is Advent's song! "Come, Lord, help us to wake up, to pay attention to your presence in everyone we meet this week. Come, Lord, help us to participate fully & consciously in all the activities of this month, large and small."



WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 6, FEAST OF ST. NICHOLAS

St. Nicholas was a bishop who lived in the 4th century. He had a reputation for giving unexpected gifts. Unexpected gifts are a lot of fun to give and to receive. The gift could be a note (or text) telling someone you love them and are praying for them this Advent.

Something else to keep in mind today: while St. Nicholas, is the patron saint of children, he is also the patron of pawnbrokers. Many people going through rough times often pawn items to purchase necessities or to feed debilitating addictions. Keep them and all the poor and hurting in your prayers.

TUESDAY, DECEMBER 5

Each Advent, as the Church begins a new Liturgical Year we also begin a different cycle of Scriptures on Sundays. This is the **Year of St. Mark** ... which goes very well with this very fast Advent we have begun. Mark's Gospel is the shortest of the four and reads the quickest. Mark can put a lot of action in just a couple of verses.

Take a look at the first chapter Mark's Gospel, verses 1-8. In the first verse alone, Mark breaks all suspense by telling us exactly who Jesus is: **"The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ the Son of God."** Jesus is the Christ, the Messiah, the Son of God. And He brings us the Good News (that's what the word "Gospel" means!) of salvation: God is with us!

Here's some more good news: you've just read the Gospel for Mass this coming Sunday, December 10th. You're two steps ahead!

MONDAY, DECEMBER 4

Keep in mind this is going to be one really fast Advent, the quickest it can possibly be: only 3 weeks and a half a day long! That's it! When time is short, we need to make the most of it. "Lord God, help my family and friends and the whole parish make the most and the best of every minute today and in the days to come!"

FRIDAY, DECEMBER 8:

FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

In our Creed we say that God is the creator of everything visible and invisible. Today's Feast celebrates how God prepared Mary long before she ever knew it — in her mother's womb! God is "sneaky" like that — in a good way! God's love and grace is at work even when we don't know it; even when we think we don't deserve it; even when we don't immediately recognize it!

We have a word for that kind of grace: prevenient! It's the grace that comes before any human decision or action. You will hear this word in the Prayer over the Gifts at today's Mass.

As Fr. JM says: God is good, all the time!
All the time, God is good!



Did you know the United States of America is consecrated to Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception? She is the Patroness of our country.

The beautiful Basilica Shrine dedicated to her sits on the campus of the Catholic University of America in Washington DC. It is the largest Catholic church building in the USA and one of the largest in the world.

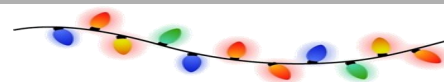

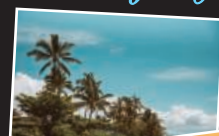
