GOSPEL

Jn 1: 35-42

John was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he said, "Behold, the Lamb of God." The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi" — which translated means Teacher —, "where are you staying?" He said to them, "Come, and you will see." So they went and saw where Jesus was staying, and they stayed with him that day. It was about four in the afternoon. Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, was one of the two who heard John and followed Jesus. He first found his own brother Simon and told him, "We have found the Messiah" — which is translated Christ —. Then he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John; you will be called Cephas" — which is translated Peter.

NEW IN '24

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It's a new year and a few new things are happening around here at St. Joan of Arc.

First, I'd like to welcome Sr. Barbara Gondek, SSC (Society of Sisters of the Church) to our Pastoral Staff. Bringing her 24 years of experience as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker, Sr. Barbara will serve in a part-time capacity as Parish Counselor. We know from Jesus Christ that God wants us to be holy, healthy and happy people. So much of holiness, healthiness and happiness depends on our mental and relational well-being. I am thrilled that Sr. Barbara will be here to minister to our parishioners in this capacity. Please check the bulletin next week for a description of the services Sr. Barbara will offer.

Second: We also know through Jesus Christ that God calls us to respect, defend and promote life from it's beginning in the womb to death. God calls us to care for the unborn, as well as for the poor, hungry, homeless, even the stranger among us. God wants us to work for the common good of all (what the Church has long called issues of peace and social justice). Additionally, God calls us to be good stewards of creation which includes the planet as a whole and the local environment we inhabit. In terms of our discipleship, these are not separate realities. They are all related. Therefore, we are beginning a new ministry called **LOVE IN ACTION: Life, Justice and Creation.**

I am grateful to Lia Romero, an SJA parishioner, who has agreed to coordinate this new ministry, working with SueAnn Jeral on our Pastoral Staff.

This is a great opportunity for those of you interested in pro-life and/or social justice and/or environmental issues to get in on the ground level of the formation of this ministry. Most parishes that I am aware of have not attempted to integrate these concerns, but I strongly believe this integrated approach is more in line with the Gospel and with Church Teaching. Furthermore, while working to better the world we live in, **LOVE IN ACTION** will not have a political agenda or be about politics. It will be the Gospel of Jesus Christ and Church Teaching that will guide, inspire, and challenge us to live the values of the Kingdom of God.

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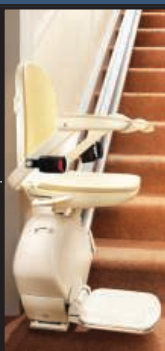
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
