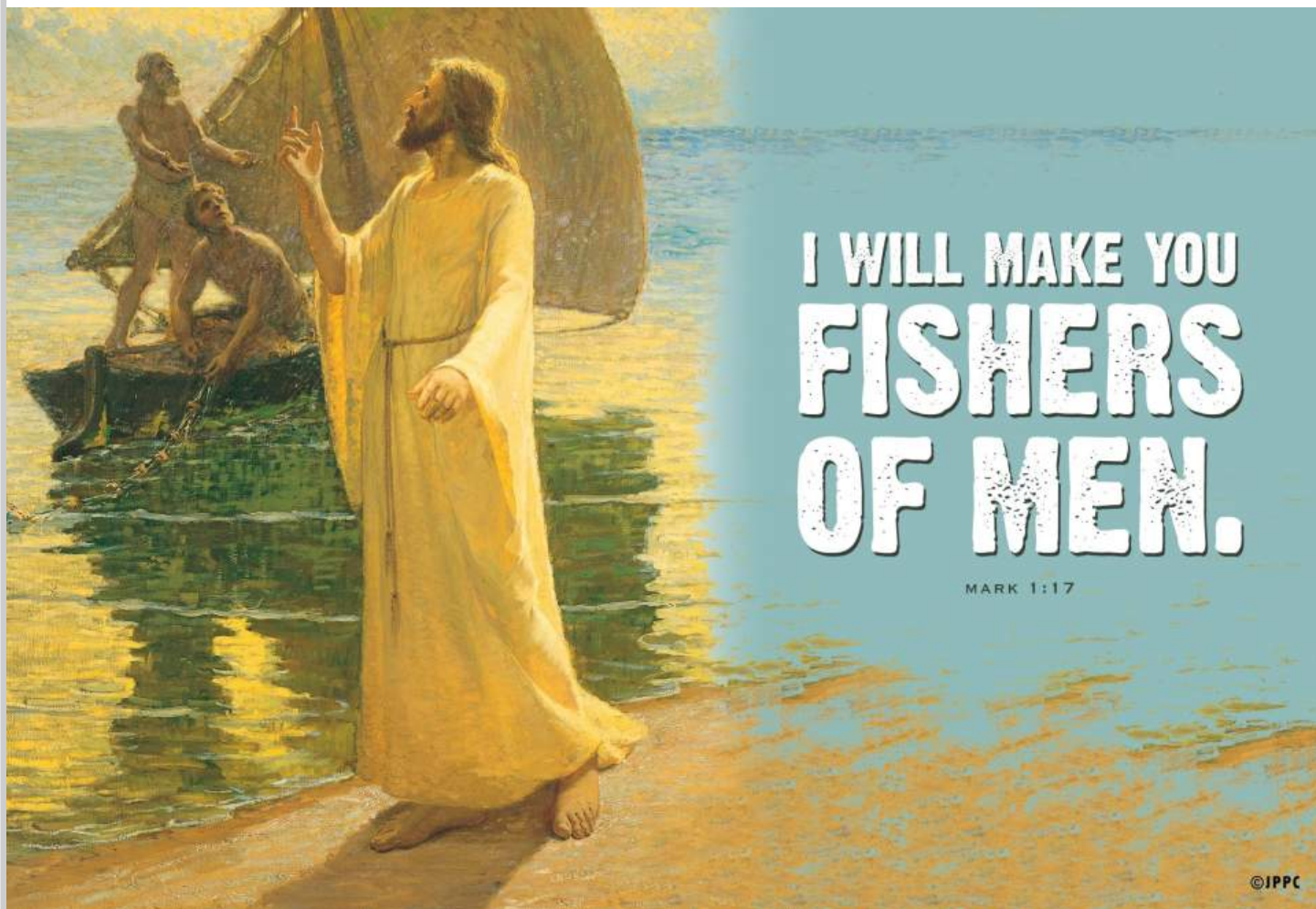

Mk 1: 14-20

After John had been arrested, Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God: "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."

As he passed by the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting their nets into the sea; they were fishermen. Jesus said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." Then they abandoned their nets and followed him. He walked along a little farther and saw James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They too were in a boat mending their nets. Then he called them. So they left their father Zebedee in the boat along with the hired men and followed him.

Let Go and Follow

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Abandon is not the most popular word, particularly when referencing the abandonment of a person or of personal responsibilities. So, in our Gospel today when Mark tells us the first followers of Jesus, namely Peter and Andrew, James and John, abandoned their jobs as fishermen and, in the case of the latter two, also their father, it doesn't sound like the greatest of beginnings.

On the other hand, perhaps Mark is telling us that to follow Jesus a certain amount of abandonment is required. Abandonment, in one of its older definitions, meant to let go of control. Would we all not agree that following Jesus does require a certain amount of letting go of control? Faith requires it. Trust requires it. Perhaps even love requires it.

If Jesus asked you today to follow Him, what would you have to drop, let go of, forego, in order to say, "yes"?

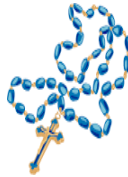

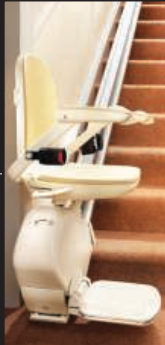
