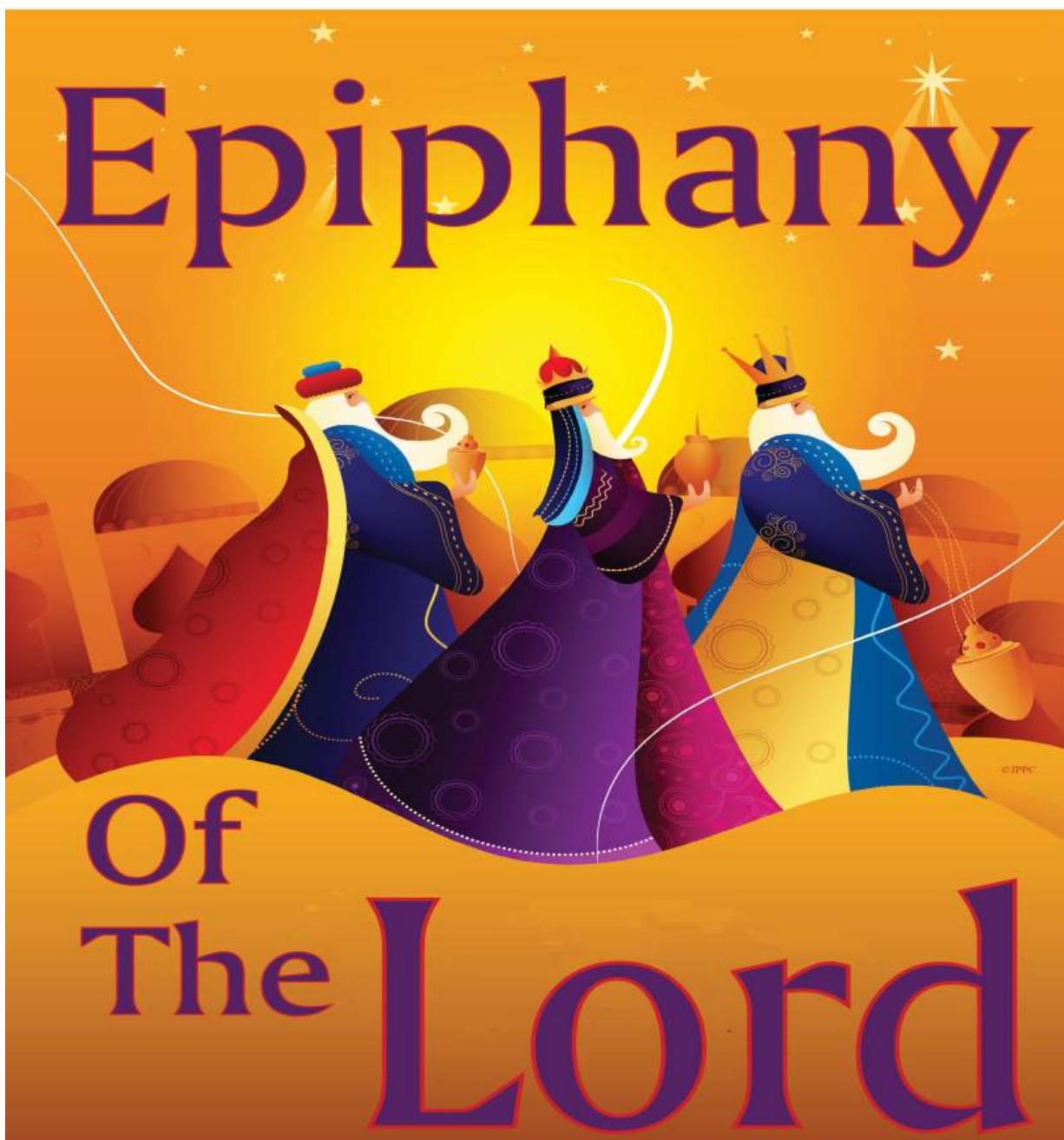

GOSPEL

Mt 2: 1-12

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage." When King Herod heard this, he was greatly troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. Assembling all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, He inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet:

And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel."

Then Herod called the magi secretly and ascertained from them the time of the star's appearance. He sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search diligently for the child. When you have found him, bring me word, that I too may go and do him homage." After their audience with the king they set out. And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way. The magi were open to being guided by the light of the star. They also agreed to take a different route home. We also must be open to the light of Jesus helping us walk through our day. When have you had to take an unexpected path, chose a different way, as the Magi, to follow God's light? What were the consequences of your new route?

Think of the best gift you received for Christmas. What was it? What made it special? Was it the gift itself or the thought that went into it or the person who gave it to you that made it special?

What word, phrase or idea spoke to you most in this Gospel reading? Ask God to help you understand what God's message is to you and why God is speaking to you through this particular Gospel.
