Jn 10: 11-18

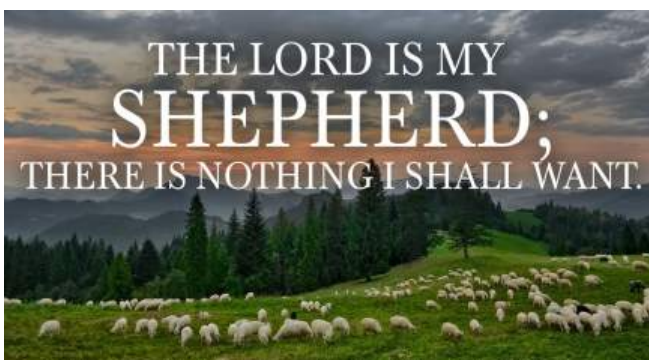
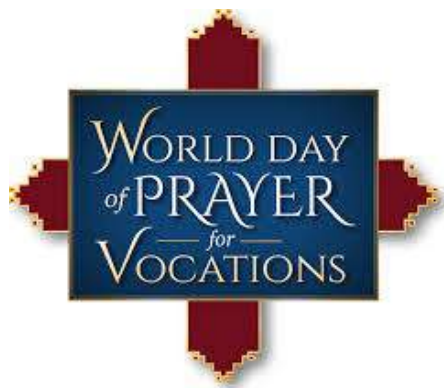
Jesus said: "I am the good shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. A hired man, who is not a shepherd and whose sheep are not his own, sees a wolf coming and leaves the sheep and runs away, and the wolf catches and scatters them. This is because he works for pay and has no concern for the sheep. I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I will lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. These also I must lead, and they will hear my voice, and there will be one flock, one shepherd. This is why the Father loves me, because I lay down my life in order to take it up again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down on my own. I have power to lay it down, and power to take it up again. This command I have received from my Father."

## FAITH SHARING QUESTIONS:

Jesus is the Good Shepherd because he lays down his life for his sheep. We are Jesus' sheep called to lay down our life for him. How does John's Gospel teach you how to be a good shepherd as Jesus? What is Jesus saying to you when he exclaims, "...they will hear my voice, and there will be one flock, one shepherd"?

Recall a moment in your life when you heard Jesus' voice? What was your initial response? Did Jesus' voice change your relationship with him? With others? What challenges do you experience in your life in order to be a good shepherd to others? When has Jesus been your Good Shepherd?



## 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter / 2024 World Day of Prayer for Vocations **EASTER CALLING**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It occurred to me recently that I don't hear the question, "When did you get the calling?" as much as I used to. This could be for a number of reasons. Maybe everyone has heard the story. Maybe because I'm older now my vocation story doesn't resonate with younger folks. Maybe people are afraid to ask me or think it's too personal a question to ask. Maybe because I am older people think I have forgotten. Maybe we've lost a sense of what it means "to be called."

More on that last note: does God still call people to service in the Church? It's no secret the number of ordained and religious (aka Sisters) is shrinking. What do you think? Has God given up?

From what I know about God from Jesus: no, God does not give up. God is love. Love doesn't give up and God loves the Church, which is the Body of Christ. I believe God is still calling both women and men to serve in the Church as clergy (priests and deacons), sisters, brothers, and lay ministers.

Would it help if the Church allowed priests to marry? I believe so. Some young men tell me they would consider the priesthood if they could marry. Would it help if the Church ordained women to the diaconate and the priesthood? Again, yes, I believe so. I am acutely aware of the fact that many women in our Church, even in our own pews, have during their lifetime felt called by God to serve in this capacity. Personally, it saddens me that this has not been an option for them. I pray that this changes, sooner than later.

I am also acutely aware of the fact that many Christian denominations who do now ordain women and married men also have a shortage of clergy. What does *that* mean?

There is a deeper crisis. A crisis of faith. We must help especially young people enter into the relationship Jesus Christ wants to have with them. We must help young people get to know Jesus and fall in love with Jesus. We must help young people see how Christ works in and through a visible community of believers, that faith is not just a private affair. We must challenge them to expand the important question, "what do I want to do with my life?" to include, "how can I best use my interests, talents and personality to serve God? How is God calling me to make a positive difference in the world today? How can I make that difference within the community of the Church?"

In the earliest days of the Church, the Holy Spirit guided the Christian Community to grow and expand its vision of God's love and also of ministry. I believe that same Spirit is at work today. God has not given up on us. We must not give up on God.

## POPCORN, FRANKS & A MOVIE

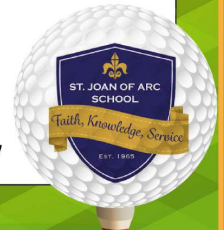
