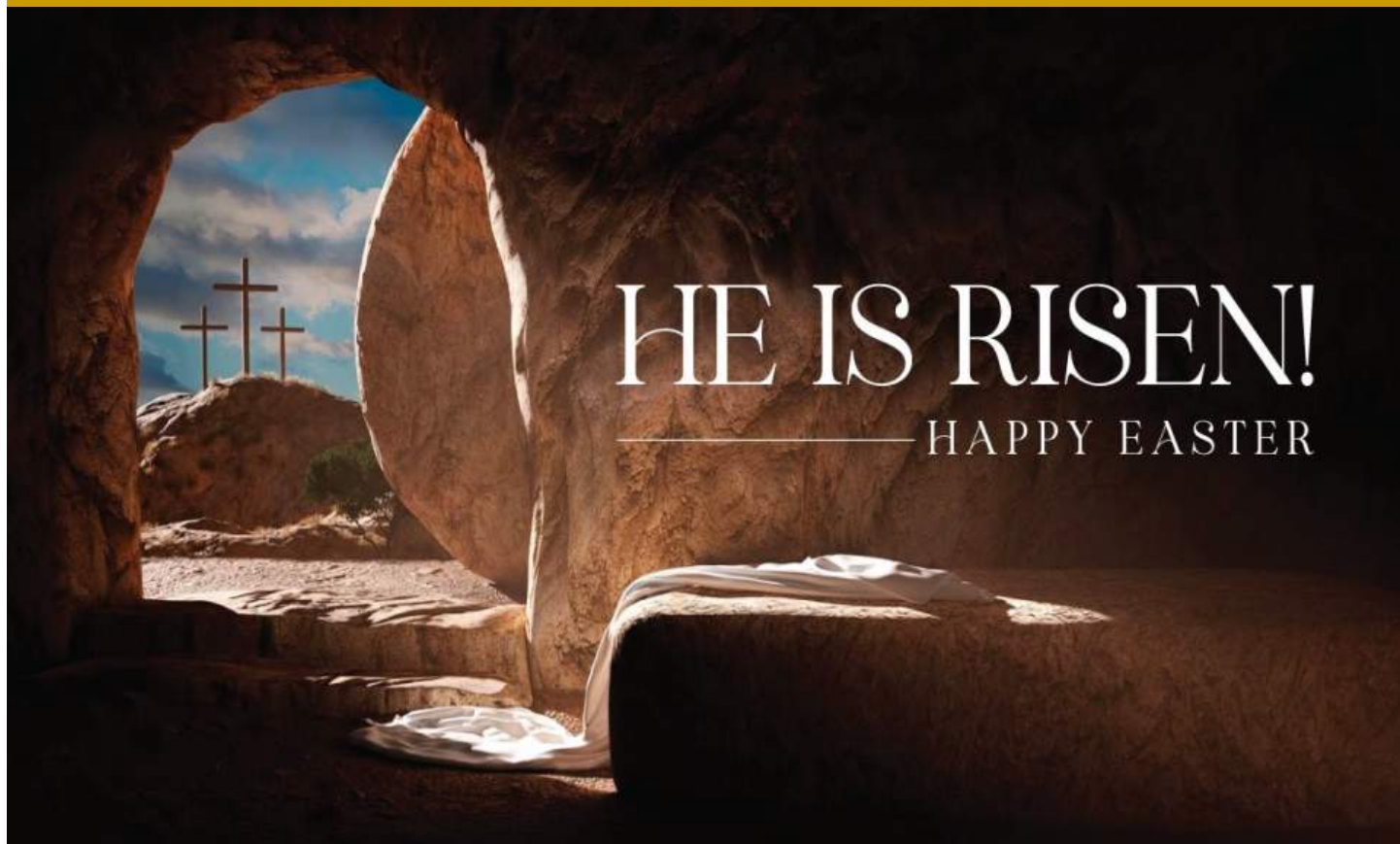

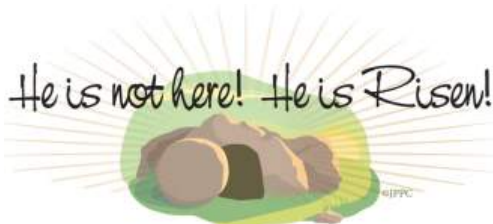

GOSPEL

Mk 15: 1-39

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead.

Easter Sunday / 2024 *THE LAMB AT EASTER*

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Easter in March. As I write this letter more than a week before you are going to read it, I wonder what the weather will be like. Could be cold. Could be snow. Could be warm. Could be warmer than Christmas (that's happened lately!).

They say (or used to say, anyway), that if March comes in like a lion it goes out like a lamb. For us as Christians, with Easter the last day of this month, no matter what the weather, March this year is going out like a lamb.

And the lamb we are talking about is the Lamb of God. And that is Jesus. Yes, Jesus Christ is the Lamb of God who sacrifices His life on the cross for the forgiveness of sin! We say it at every Mass: "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world."

This Lamb makes us one with God in a covenant, a relationship that is eternal. Try as we might, we cannot break this relationship of love that we have with God. Oh, we can ignore it. We can deny it and not believe it. We can even ridicule it, if we want to. We can behave as if God doesn't exist or that God is irrelevant. That's our choice. But it won't stop God from loving us. That is what the Lamb of God on Easter wants to tell us.

If we do believe it, it changes our life. It changes the way we live. It changes the way we look at ourselves and the world. It changes the way we look even at death.

This year, March goes out with the Lamb of God. Let's go out and with the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ, every day until the day we join in the heavenly feast, the Supper of the Lamb in heaven, the very feast every Mass foreshadows.

EASTER SUNDAY'S EUCHARISTIC WORD:

DYING/RISING

The First Eucharist was on the First Easter

Many people might not realize that the very first time disciples of Jesus experienced His real presence in the breaking of bread occurred on the evening of Christ's resurrection — the very first Easter! "We knew him in the breaking of the bread," they said. This is what the first Christians called Mass, the Eucharist. The first generation of Christians immediately began to gather every Sunday to break bread. In doing so they remembered and celebrated Christ's dying and rising. We do the same every time we gather for Mass.

**It is truly right and just,
our duty and our salvation,
at all times to praise you, O Lord,
but especially on the Easter Day
when Christ our Passover
has been sacrificed and raised.**

**For He is the true Lamb
who has taken away
the sins of the world;**

***by dying He has destroyed our death;
and by rising,
He has restored our life!***

(taken from the Preface of the Eucharistic Prayer for Easter Sunday)

THIS IS REALLY IMPORTANT

The **PASCHAL (Easter) MYSTERY** refers to the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. It includes Christ's Ascension, His return to the Father, and the giving of His Holy Spirit (Pentecost). Christ sends out His Church to be His Body, His presence in the world. At every Mass we celebrate the Paschal Mystery. At every Mass we are fed with the Body of Christ in the Eucharist so that we can be sent into the world to be Christ for one another!

Dear Parishioners,

Peace! Happy Easter! Hopefully your Lenten journey has brought you to a deeper understanding of the Eucharist. We at school have participated in reading and discussing the “Lenten Word” for the day. It was a great way to be connected to our parish community.

March was filled with many activities. Celebrating liturgy with you, our parishioners, is always the highlight of the week. In between the weeks we celebrated: Read Across America, Dr. Seuss, Brain Week, Albert Einstein’s birthday, St. Patrick’s Day, St. Joseph’s Day and Women’s History Month. We ended our Lenten journey with a mini Triduum. On Holy Thursday we revisited our opening September song, *Love Can Build a Bridge*, followed by teachers washing the hands of students, consuming bread and juice and reflecting on how Eucharist is the **Bridge to Unity**. We remembered Good Friday by watching a video of Jesus, praying the Stations of the Cross, and visiting the three crosses in front of the church. Holy Saturday was recognized by having quiet time reflecting on the need for silence before the tomb as we waited for Jesus to rise from the dead. When we return after Easter we will proclaim the Resurrection of Jesus. Alleluia, Alleluia.

Special thanks to Mrs. Jessica Donohue, Mrs. Debbie Galamb and all of the catechists, teachers and volunteers who helped our children on their Eucharistic Retreat Day. We are very grateful.

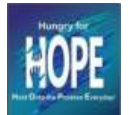
