Be Not Afraid

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Do you remember your Confirmation? At our Liturgy Meeting this past Tuesday we shared our Confirmation memories. Some were vivid; others could hardly remember. Although one common theme among us, whether we were confirmed in the third or fourth grade or in eighth grade, seemed to be that we were all a little bit (or more than a little bit) afraid.

Afraid. Not so much of the Holy Spirit. We were more afraid of the Bishop who was going to be asking questions during the Confirmation ceremony. And, yes, also, a little bit afraid of our teachers who were drilling us.

Fear locks us up. Fear immobilizes. Fear builds fences and defenses and defense mechanisms. And all of this is the direct opposite of what the Holy Spirit does in our lives as disciples of Christ.

The gift of the Holy Spirit — Christ's life within us here and now — opens us up, empowers us, moves us and sets us free to love in new ways! That is what the Spirit did in the lives of the first apostles and disciples, the first Church, and that is what the Spirit is still doing some twenty centuries later.

The Holy Spirit is moving us into a deeper union with God and with each other. Why should anyone be afraid of that?

Come, Holy Spirit!

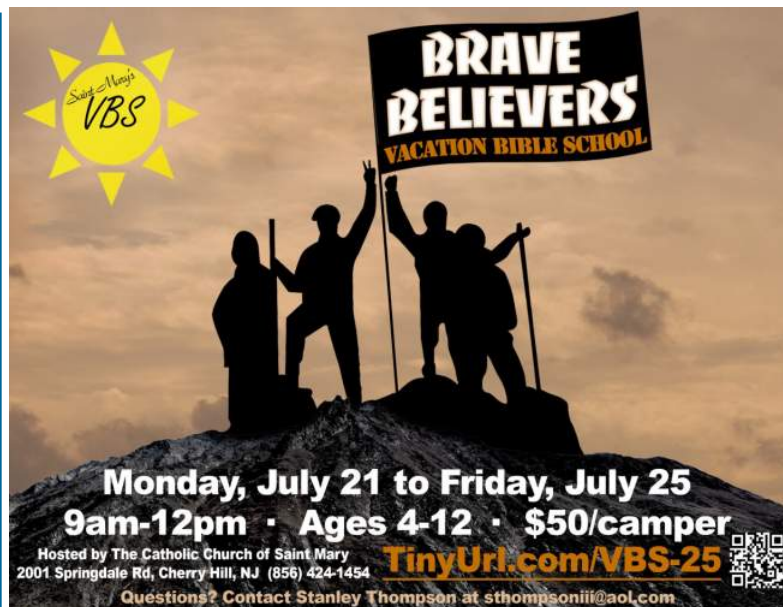

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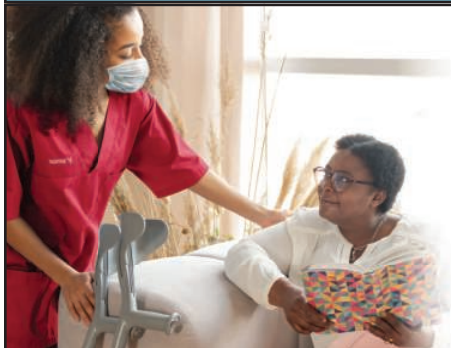
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
