GOSPEL

Luke 12:13-21

Someone in the crowd said to Jesus, "Teacher, tell my brother to share the inheritance with me." He replied to him, "Friend, who appointed me as your judge and arbitrator?" Then he said to the crowd, "Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions."

Then he told them a parable. "There was a rich man whose land produced a bountiful harvest. He asked himself, 'What shall I do, for I do not have space to store my harvest?' And he said, 'This is what I shall do: I shall tear down my barns and build larger ones. There I shall store all my grain and other goods and I shall say to myself, "Now as for you, you have so many good things stored up for many years, rest, eat, drink, be merry!"' But God said to him, 'You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you; and the things you have prepared, to whom will they belong?' Thus will it be for all who store up treasure for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God."

18th Sunday in Ordinary Time / 2025 **A MOMENT WITH COLOSSIANS**

Dear Parishioners and Friends

Colossians. In print, it might look like it has something to do with the colon. Verbally, it is often mispronounced, sounding more like Colosseums, as if the people St. Paul was writing to lived in the big "arena" in Rome. Probably written in Rome while he was imprisoned, Paul's letter is in fact addressed to the people of Colossae, a town in Asia Minor (current day Turkey).

I should tell you, in a spirit of transparency, that Biblical scholars today debate over the authorship of the Letter to the Colossians, although earliest Christian bishops and theologians accepted St. Paul as the author.

We have been hearing from this Letter to the Colossians every Sunday since July 13th. I've wanted to preach about it, but the Gospels have been so compelling these past weeks I felt I needed to address them. Today our Second Reading once more, for the last time this summer, comes from Colossians.

Who writes this letter isn't nearly as important as what is written in it ... and especially what is written about Jesus. I am amazed, truly amazed, that in thirty some years after the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, this can be written of him: "Christ Jesus is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation! For in Him were created all things in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible." (We say almost the exact same words every Sunday in the Nicene Creed.) "Christ is before all this, and in Him all things hold together." And, as we hear this Sunday: "Christ is all and in all."

I will tell you who wrote the Letter to the Colossians. The Holy Spirit! Such revelations about who Christ Jesus is could only come from God!

It would be worth it for all of us to read this Letter, or, at the very least, revisit the Second Reading from this Sunday and the three before it. It will truly expand our understanding of who Jesus the Christ is, was, and always will be.
