### IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM EVESHAM POLICE

In order to ensure the continued safety and enjoyment of those attending the event this year, Monsignor Richard LaVerghetta, the St. Joan of Arc Carnival Committee, and the Evesham Police Department have implemented the following security plan:

- The entire carnival area is now fenced. While there is no admission charge, there will be three points of entry: left side of the parking lot of the church off of Willow Bend Road, rear parking lot of the school off of Evans Road, and the pedestrian walkway off of Wheatland Court.
- Face coverings and backpacks are strictly prohibited, and will not be permitted inside the carnival area. Any exceptions for backpacks for medical and/or infant/small child use are subject to inspection.

Officers from the Evesham Police Department will be on location each night of the carnival at the three points of entry and throughout the interior and exterior of the event to provide safety and assistance for all those in attendance.


### **United States Conference of Catholic Bishops**


