

GOSPEL

Luke 14:25-33

Great crowds were traveling with Jesus, and he turned and addressed them, “If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple. Which of you wishing to construct a tower does not first sit down and calculate the cost to see if there is enough for its completion? Otherwise, after laying the foundation and finding himself unable to finish the work the onlookers should laugh at him and say, ‘This one began to build but did not have the resources to finish.’ Or what king marching into battle would not first sit down and decide whether with ten thousand troops he can successfully oppose another king advancing upon him with twenty thousand troops? But if not, while he is still far away, he will send a delegation to ask for peace terms. In the same way, anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple.”

Security

Dear Parishioners and Friends

While I would much prefer to write about the excitement of a new school year, sadly I feel I must address the terrible act of violence that occurred on Wednesday, August 27, taking the lives of 2 school children in Minneapolis and injuring many others.

Every shooting is a tragedy for all involved: the victims, their families and the community. Every shooting, no matter where — in a school, a theatre, a shopping mall, on a city street, or in a synagogue or a church — is against the will of God and something we, as disciples of Jesus, should abhor and work to prevent. The violence of August 27 hits home a little more for us because its victims attended a parochial school and the shooting took place in Church during Mass.

In light of that event, please know:

—On the day of the shooting I spoke with the Chief of the Evesham Police Department, Thomas Reinholt, who assured me of greater police presence during the school week.

—Since the school shooting in Parkland, Florida, back in 2018, we have had a School Resource Officer present every day in our school as well as at all school Masses in Church.

—Since 2023 we also have a Security Officer present in the building while our children attend Religious Education during the school year and during the Summer Program.

—For several years we have been implementing a Security Plan developed for the School and Church in conjunction with the Evesham Police which includes additional security cameras (which the Police have access to), installation of 3M security film on windows in school and church, clearing of underbrush around the church. The plan was revised and updated just as recently as this past Spring.

Please be assured that we have always and will continue to take very seriously the safety of our children and everyone who gathers here for worship and for other parish and school activities. I am very grateful to all, in particular our local police here in Evesham, who helped us have a peaceful and safe Carnival week. As we begin the new school year, let's pray and work for the same, for us, our children, and for everyone in the country.

Pope Leo XIV and Care for Creation

Many of the Catholic faithful have been waiting to see if Pope Leo XIV will follow Pope Francis with respect to his attention to Care for Creation. Initial indications are that he will. Pope Leo's recent actions include:

- Acknowledging the 10-year anniversary of *Laudato Si'* and commenting on the extraordinary impact, and countless initiatives inspired by the work.
- Sending a video message to the Network of Universities for the Care of Our Common Home encouraging their mission: "...to be builders of bridges...working for ecological, social, and environmental justice."
- Celebrating the very first "*Mass for the Care of Creation*," a new formulary of the Roman Missal.
- Issuing the 10th *World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation* which calls environmental degradation a "justice" issue and includes prayers of hope that *Laudato Si'* and integral ecology be increasingly accepted as the right path to follow.

Leo has stated that "We must also pray for the conversion of many people, both inside and outside the Church, who still do not recognize the urgency of caring for our common home."




