

GOSPEL

Luke 16:1-13

Jesus said to his disciples, "A rich man had a steward who was reported to him for squandering his property. He summoned him and said, 'What is this I hear about you? Prepare a full account of your stewardship, because you can no longer be my steward.' The steward said to himself, 'What shall I do, now that my master is taking the position of steward away from me? I am not strong enough to dig and I am ashamed to beg. I know what I shall do so that, when I am removed from the stewardship, they may welcome me into their homes.' He called in his master's debtors one by one. To the first he said, 'How much do you owe my master?' He replied, 'One hundred measures of olive oil.' He said to him, 'Here is your promissory note. Sit down and quickly write one for fifty.' Then to another the steward said, 'And you, how much do you owe?' He replied, 'One hundred kors of wheat.' The steward said to him, 'Here is your promissory note; write one for eighty.' And the master commended that dishonest steward for acting prudently.

"For the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light. I tell you, make friends for yourselves with dishonest wealth, so that when it fails, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings. The person who is trustworthy in very small matters is also trustworthy in great ones; and the person who is dishonest in very small matters is also dishonest in great ones. If, therefore, you are not trustworthy with dishonest wealth, who will trust you with true wealth? If you are not trustworthy with what belongs to another, who will give you what is yours? No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon."

25th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME/2025 **WHAT WOULD YOU DO WITH....?**

Dear Parishioners and Friends

It was just a couple of weeks ago we were all talking about what we would do if we hit the Powerball and won over a billion dollars. It is almost too ridiculous to even consider, and yet, whenever the jackpot grows that big, we all play that game. Imagine how many friends would show up out of nowhere and imagine how many new friends we could make with all that money.

Never mind a billion, what would you do with a million? Never mind that, what are you doing with what you've got already in your wallet (if anything) or in the bank (if anything) or anywhere else you keep or grow or hide your money (if you have any)?

In a very roundabout way, I think this is what Jesus is getting at in today's Gospel which includes one of the oddest parables Jesus tells. (The Church gives us the option to read a short version this week which eliminates the parable, I guess to make it a bit easier on the preacher ... and the people, too. You can read the whole thing in this bulletin or in your own Bible: Luke 16:1-13).

This Sunday's Parable of the "Dishonest but very Fast-Thinking, Crafty Steward" is sandwiched between the "Parable of the Prodigal Son" and the "Parable of the Rich Man and Lazarus." While there are many layers of meaning in all three, each interestingly involves money. Who says Jesus didn't live in the real world?

All three stories also involve relationships: father and son, employer and employee, loaner and loanee, rich and poor. Leave it to Jesus point out that money can complicate life and how we relate to each other. Jesus knows only too well how money can drive a wedge between people.

As always, Jesus challenges us to put the Kingdom of God first. So, when it comes to that, to the Kingdom of God, what are we doing with all that we have been given, including our paycheck.


