## 28th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME/2025 *Out of Breath Christians*

Dear Parishioners and Friends

Our great Eucharistic Prayer begins with a dialogue between the priest and the people. "Lift up your hearts!" the priest says. And you, the people, respond: "We lift them up to the Lord!" At this point, both priest and people should be exhausted! But then the priest ramps it up a notch: "Let us give thanks and praise to the Lord our God!!" "It is right and just," you say. "It's our duty and salvation," the priest exclaims ... giving thanks is what saves us!!

I love that the Eucharistic Prayer, a prayer about giving thanks, begins with such joy and exuberance! The words themselves want to lift us up out of our doldrums, our negativism and cynicism, even our sadness and fear and weariness.

There seems to be an intimate connection between giving thanks and joy ... and hope, too! Think about it.

This Sunday we hear the same Gospel we proclaim every Thanksgiving Day. A leper returns to give thanks to Jesus for being healed (Luke 17:11-19). I can't imagine the man sauntered over to Jesus; no, he had to be running and out of breath, so filled with joy and hope!

By the end of every Mass, we too should be out of breath, filled with joy, having heard God's Word, having been filled with God's life and love in the Eucharist! Hopefully we are not running out of Mass just to be the first out of the parking lot. Hopefully we are running out to be the one to announce to the world the Good News that saves us!
