

Jesus addressed this parable to those who were convinced of their own righteousness and despised everyone else. "Two people went up to the temple area to pray; one was a Pharisee and the other was a tax collector. The Pharisee took up his position and spoke this prayer to himself, 'O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity -- greedy, dishonest, adulterous -- or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, and I pay tithes on my whole income.' But the tax collector stood off at a distance and would not even raise his eyes to heaven but beat his breast and prayed, 'O God, be merciful to me a sinner.' I tell you, the latter went home justified, not the former; for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted." ## Praying: Round Two

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Prayer, again. Like last Sunday, the Church gives us Scriptures that once again highlight the importance of prayer in our lives as disciples of Jesus Christ.

Last Sunday we heard Jesus tell us to pray without growing weary. We heard how we are called to help one another pray — thus one of the reasons we gather together each Sunday ... to help one another to lift up our hearts to God!

Speaking of the heart ... this Sunday Jesus gives us the short but powerful parable about two very different kinds of prayers and pray-ers (Luke 18:9-14). One type of prayer, from the "church-going" Pharisee, is self-centered and meant to impress God and anyone else in earshot. The other type, from the nasty tax collector, is from the heart, directed to God, humble and contrite.

When we pray, is it more to impress God, or even to convince God to see things our way? Or, can we humbly give God in prayer our heart and whatever is in it: the ache, the joy, the shame, the fear and worry, the hope.

Furthermore, does our prayer unite us with those who are considered "the least"? We cannot get away from this question. Notice how the Church links Jesus' parable on authentic prayer with a passage from the Book of Sirach (35:12-14,16-18) in the Old Testament which reminds us how God hears "the cry of the oppressed ... the orphan ... the widow ... lowly. God hears their prayers. Can we hear them, too?

We are especially grateful to our dedicated catechists, who generously share their time and gifts with our community. Please keep them in your prayers as they guide our children on their faith journey throughout the year.


### Volunteer Opportunities

## Humility: The Secret History of a Lost Virtue

Christopher Bellitto, Ph.D.  
Kean University, New Jersey

How can we rescue the ancient and medieval virtue of humility from the modern idea of humiliation? Can we use what Dante called "the first virtue" to fight hybris, arrogance, and narcissism today? Join us as we explore a biography of humility,
