GOSPEL

John 2:13-22

Since the Passover of the Jews was near, Jesus went up to Jerusalem. He found in the temple area those who sold oxen, sheep, and doves, as well as the money-changers seated there. He made a whip out of cords and drove them all out of the temple area, with the sheep and oxen, and spilled the coins of the money-changers and overturned their tables, and to those who sold doves he said, "Take these out of here, and stop making my Father's house a marketplace." His disciples recalled the words of Scripture, Zeal for your house will consume me. At this the Jews answered and said to him, "What sign can you show us for doing this?" Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up." The Jews said, "This temple has been under construction for forty-six years, and you will raise it up in three days?" But he was speaking about the temple of his Body. Therefore, when he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they came to believe the Scripture and the word Jesus had spoken.

WHAT'S IN A BUILDING?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Which Church building in all of Christendom is considered "the mother and head of all Churches"? St. Peter's, of course, in Vatican City. That's how most of us would answer ... and, unfortunately, most of us would be wrong.

"The mother and head of all Churches of the city and of the world" is the Basilica of St. John Lateran in Rome. Many times referred to as the Lateran Basilica, or simply, John Lateran, this Church is the Cathedral Church of the Bishop of Rome who is the Pope, the successor of St. Peter.

John Lateran was built in the Fourth Century (324 AD) during the reign of the Emperor Constantine and was dedicated to Christ the Savior in honor of Saints John the Baptist and John the Evangelist. The Lateran part of the name comes from the name of the ancient Roman family who owned the property where the Church was built.

Popes lived next to it for centuries. Five ecumenical Councils were held there. We celebrate its dedication every year on November 9th.

Just as the Pope's primary ministry is one of unity, so, then, this Arch Basilica (the only archbasilica in the world), is seen as a visible expression of the unity of all the faithful, all the followers of Christ. So, today, while remembering an important date in our Church's history, we also celebrate our oneness, our unity in Christ. And while we honor this ancient building, we remember that the Church is made up of "living stones," "the People of God," disciples of Jesus Christ!




Requirements to become an EMHC:

Help Those in Need Get Their Taxes Done For Free

Each year AARP volunteers offer free assistance to low and middle-income taxpayers in the preparation of their federal and state tax returns. Sites usually are open one day a week, from February 1st until April 15th. Clients and volunteers do not have to be members of AARP or a senior to participate in this program.

In order to keep the program going we need volunteers willing to work as Tax Counselors and Client Facilitators. All returns are done on AARP provided Chromebook computers and electronically filed. Tax Counselors should be comfortable using a computer and willing to learn how to prepare non-complex returns. Client Facilitators should be comfortable welcoming clients and assisting them checking in. New Tax Counselors will receive four days training in early December, another three days training in January and ample resources to ready them for tax preparation.
