## GOSPEL

## Luke 21:5-19

While some people were speaking about how the temple was adorned with costly stones and votive offerings, Jesus said, "All that you see here-- the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down."

Then they asked him, "Teacher, when will this happen? And what sign will there be when all these things are about to happen?" He answered, "See that you not be deceived, for many will come in my name, saying, 'I am he,' and 'The time has come.' Do not follow them! When you hear of wars and insurrections, do not be terrified; for such things must happen first, but it will not immediately be the end." Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be powerful earthquakes, famines, and plagues from place to place; and awesome sights and mighty signs will come from the sky.

"Before all this happens, however, they will seize and persecute you, they will hand you over to the synagogues and to prisons, and they will have you led before kings and governors because of my name. It will lead to your giving testimony. Remember, you are not to prepare your defense beforehand, for I myself shall give you a wisdom in speaking that all your adversaries will be powerless to resist or refute. You will even be handed over by parents, brothers, relatives, and friends, and they will put some of you to death. You will be hated by all because of my name, but not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

## 33RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME / 2025 **CONFIRMATION IS COMING!**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We hear Malachi the prophet ringing out, "The days are coming!" For us here at St. Joan of Arc, a really important day is coming this Wednesday ... Confirmation!

The Bishop's representative, Rev. Msgr. Dennis Apoldite, will preside as 115 of our Ninth Graders are sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation. As in prior years, each of the Confirmandi has written me a personal letter requesting the Sacrament. I am so grateful for the time each young person took to tell me a little bit about themselves and why they want to be Confirmed. They also tell me how they have prepared for this Sacrament through study, prayer and service.

This year many of the Candidates told me how important Sunday Mass is for them. For example, one young man (I don't want to embarrass anyone so I'll withhold names) wrote, "going to church every Sunday with my family is honestly one of my favorite hours of the week. I am the type of boy who worries about school, tests, and everything on my schedule" and "when I go church on Sunday, my relationship with God brings me comfort and peace and makes my week better." Beautifully said... and I think we can all agree with him.

Another Confirmandi, a young woman whom I see each Sunday at Mass, wrote, "My faith has been a beacon of hope and helps me stay at ease. My faith has helped me through hard times and getting confirmed reminds me to keep going and that God is always with me."

In an age filled with so much anxiety and stress, our kids need faith and Church and Sunday Mass now more than ever. Fr. JM and I are seeing more and more families and young people at Sunday Mass. We want to encourage everyone to keep coming! We know it is not always easy to get here, but Sunday Mass makes a difference in our lives. It strengthens our faith. It reduces anxiety and provides hope. It helps us deal with life's difficult challenges. It helps us feel connected to God and to a community. It helps us to know we are never alone and always loved!

May God bless each and every one of the 115 disciples who will be confirmed this Wednesday, as well as their families and sponsors. Let's support them with our prayers and also our example. Recommit yourself to your faith this week. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you live as a faithful, loving and joyful Christian!




