## GOSPEL

## Matthew 3:1-12

John the Baptist appeared, preaching in the desert of Judea and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" It was of him that the prophet Isaiah had spoken when he said: A voice of one crying out in the desert, Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths. John wore clothing made of camel's hair and had a leather belt around his waist. His food was locusts and wild honey. At that time Jerusalem, all Judea, and the whole region around the Jordan were going out to him and were being baptized by him in the Jordan River as they acknowledged their sins.

When he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to his baptism, he said to them, "You brood of vipers! Who warned you to flee from the coming wrath? Produce good fruit as evidence of your repentance. And do not presume to say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' For I tell you, God can raise up children to Abraham from these stones. Even now the ax lies at the root of the trees. Therefore every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire. I am baptizing you with water, for repentance, but the one who is coming after me is mightier than I. I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fan is in his hand. He will clear his threshing floor and gather his wheat into his barn, but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire."

## ADVENT'S QUESTION

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Oppression. Excessive taxation. Big gap between the haves and have nots, between the powerful and the voiceless. That was first century Palestine, when and where Jesus was born, grew up and began His ministry. Gloomy times, you might say. A far cry from Isaiah's vision of the lamb inviting the wolf in for a cup a tea, or the cow and the bear behaving neighborly. A far cry from the vision of justice presented by the prophets.

You might be thinking, not much has changed in 2000 years.

What would it take for us to make that kind of world, the kind of which Isaiah speaks in our first reading today? What would it take to move "lamb" and "wolves" to sit at the same table? Advent raises this question for us. Yes, in the midst of all the things we have to get done to get ready for Christmas (and there is a lot to be done in what feels like a short time), the Holy Spirit invites us to ask this important question.

How to overcome isolation? How to overcome the fear that keeps people from living in harmony? How to overcome the hatred and prejudice that drives a wedge between peoples?

John the Baptist in our Gospel calls the people "to repent." When we hear that word, repent, we might think of asking for forgiveness, or cease sinning. It is surely that. But perhaps there is more to it. We are told by Biblical scholars that repentance involves a radical change of heart and mind.

Could it be that our Advent preparation involves a radical change in the way we think? What would that mean for you? Trust me, I know it's tough to consider such things when our heads are woozy from eating too many cookies, when all we hear on the radio is how "Grandma got run over by a reindeer," but this is important. Isaiah and John the Baptist are speaking to us today. These are gloomy times, too, but surely they don't have to be.

God wants to move us to a new place. God has always wanted to move us to what we, for lack of a better word, call His Kingdom.

Let's not stop asking Advent's question.
