GOSPEL

Matthew 11:2-11

When John the Baptist heard in prison of the works of the Christ, he sent his disciples to Jesus with this question, "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?"

Jesus said to them in reply, "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them. And blessed is the one who takes no offense at me."

As they were going off, Jesus began to speak to the crowds about John, "What did you go out to the desert to see? A reed swayed by the wind? Then what did you go out to see?

Someone dressed in fine clothing? Those who wear fine clothing are in royal palaces. Then why did you go out? To see a prophet? Yes, I tell you, and more than a prophet. This is the one about whom it is written: Behold, I am sending my messenger ahead of you; he will prepare your way before you. Amen, I say to you, among those born of women there has been none greater than John the Baptist; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he."

SOME ADVENT QUESTIONS

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

It's a question. John the Baptist asks it. He asks it of Jesus. John's question is for Jesus. "Are you the Messiah, or should we look for another?"

Are you a bit mystified? Confused? Or scandalized? Isn't John the Baptist the cousin of Jesus? Did John, a relative of Jesus', not know for sure that Jesus is the Messiah, the Savior, the Son of God? Is that what the question infers?

Perhaps. Are you okay with that? Does it frighten you or challenge you or excite you?

It's one of the things I love about our Scriptures. The writers don't whitewash or smooth over the rough spots. They could have very easily been embarrassed by John's question and therefore left it out. Some monk in the Middle Ages, copying the sacred manuscript by hand could have thought he was doing us a favor by deleting the entire scene.

Like St. Peter denying Jesus three times. Did they have to leave in all three denials? One would have been bad enough.

Or, even closer to Christmas, the angel visits Mary and tells her she is with child, with God's child, and her first reaction is, "How can this be?" After Joseph finds out Mary is pregnant, he thinks he might just quietly divorce her.

To me, all of this shows the validity of the Gospels, and also their "realness." They tell our story, too, because we have questions. Even those of us who have been Christian all our lives may sometimes wonder about the identity of Jesus Christ. Or, perhaps, after a moment of sinfulness, we've thought, "How could it be that God would love and forgive me?" Or, when the going got rough, when our faith has been tested, perhaps we've been tempted to cut and run and take the easier path.

Advent gives us an opportunity to reflect on the identity of Jesus. Ask yourself, "Who is Jesus for me? What kind of Messiah and Savior, do I think He is? Do my ideas of Jesus match up with whom the Gospels say He is, or with what Jesus says about Himself? What does it mean for me to call myself His disciple? How does discipleship impact my life, my choices, my relationships, as well as the way I think about the world and even about God?"

Let these Advent days move you into a greater, deeper conversation about Jesus. I believe you'll be all the better for it. So will your Christmas.

For Reflection and Prayer

Is there a difference between happiness and joy?

Where do you find your deepest joy?

In our Second Reading today, St. James tells us "to be patient until the coming of the Lord."

We pray often for patience.

How is the Lord moving you into greater patience? Is there something within you (i.e. attitude or perspective) that needs to change in order to be a more patient person?

What is the relationship between patience and joy?

In the early years of the Church, Advent lasted 40 days, just like Lent. Someone in the Church recognized, however, that our preparing for the Coming of the Lord needs, not just penance, but at least a spot of joy. So, by the 8th or 9th century, the Church officially added a pink candle to "soften up" the season. Joy must be a part of our lives as Christians. When we cannot find joy and beauty and goodness in the world, in others, even in ourselves, perhaps we have not fully let the grace of God open up our eyes and hearts.
