## GOSPEL

## Matthew 1:18-24

This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about. When his mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found with child through the Holy Spirit. Joseph her husband, since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame, decided to divorce her quietly. Such was his intention when, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins." All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel, which means "God is with us." When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took his wife into his home.

## 4TH Sunday of Advent / 2025 CHRISTMAS ANNUNCIATIONS

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We know that Mary has an Annunciation, that is, a visit from an angel (Gabriel; we celebrate that event on March 25th, 9 months before the birth of Christ). Joseph also has an Annunciation, though not as recognized nor so named. We hear this Sunday of an angel speaking to Joseph while he sleeps. The angel's message? Be not afraid, Joseph. Trust the presence and guidance of the Holy Spirit!

Advent wants to move us from fear to trust! Trust in God's promise to always be with us! Trust that God's Spirit surrounds and fills us, guiding us to goodness and truth and love! This is what Jesus himself was announcing when He said, "The Kingdom of God upon you." God is with us!

minors. The Diocese has in place a Victim's Assistance Coordinator, who is available to obtain support for your needs and help you make a formal complaint of abuse. If you have been sexually abused as a minor by a member of the clergy or anyone representing the Catholic Church, or if you know of someone who was, you can report that abuse through the diocesan Abuse Hotline:


