

Solemnity of the Baptism of our Lord / 2026 **BAPTISM: THINK BODY OF CHRIST**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In baptism a person becomes incorporated into Christ, made one with Christ, clothed in Christ, a new creation. Original sin is forgiven, meaning nothing can separate us from the love of God that comes to us through Christ Jesus. In baptism we become a Christian, our walk as a disciple of Christ begins — a walk in and with the Church which is the Body of Christ. We walk together as "children of the light," called and empowered by the Holy Spirit, celebrated in Confirmation, to continue the work and ministry of Jesus: to heal and forgive, to reconcile and bring hope and peace to the world... to do all that Jesus did. This is the mission of the Church which in baptism becomes the mission of the individual Christian.

You can see baptism is not a private event, nor is it simply a "spiritual experience." While the gift of salvation is given to the individual, as disciples we respond to that gift in a very corporal, bodily way, living each day in Christ with the members of the Church, His Body. Baptism is the entrance way to the other Sacraments which are all meant to strengthen us as disciples of Christ, to help us live as one Body and to love others the way Christ loves us (which was the new command Jesus gave to His followers at the Last Supper).

Baptism is a joyful celebration of God's love but also implies a serious commitment on the part of the child's parents and Godparents. It is a time for their own faith in Christ to be deepened and their participation in the life of the Church, particularly Sunday Mass, to be energized.

As we celebrate today the baptism of Jesus, let's do our part in praying for all who were baptized here at St. Joan of Arc last year, and for all who will be baptized this year. Let's welcome these parents and their children warmly and enthusiastically each Sunday. Let's also set the example of how to live the life of a disciple with great mercy and compassion, joyfully, patiently, ready to serve others who are hurting and in need, eager to celebrate, proclaim and share the love of God with all people... no exceptions.





United States Conference of Catholic Bishops

The Diocese of Trenton is committed to the initiatives outlined in the U.S Bishops' Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People in regard to the reporting and investigation of sexual abuse allegations involving minors. The Diocese has in place a Victim's Assistance Coordinator, who is available to obtain support for your needs and help you make a formal complaint of abuse. If you have been sexually abused as a minor by a member of the clergy or anyone representing the Catholic Church, or if you know of someone who was, you can report that abuse through the diocesan Abuse Hotline:

The Diocese encourages anyone with an allegation to also report that abuse to their local law enforcement agency. The Diocese reports all allegations received to the appropriate county prosecutor's office.




