

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Well, hopefully by now we have all recovered from the Eagles' disappointing loss last Sunday. If there is one lesson to learn from that game, as well as most of the past season, I think it is: two quarters isn't enough. You have to play all four. You have to play four quarters.

We could say the same about life, I suppose. Those who are in their fourth quarter of life, like myself, have come to see that every stage of life, while having its struggles and limitations, also brings new opportunities to grow and learn, to love more deeply. Life isn't a game ... it's a gift ... and each day, each year, each birthday and passing year brings another opportunity to experience God's presence in a new way.

Like in football and life, we should enter fully into all four quarters of our walk with God ... however long each of those quarters will be (and none of us knows that for sure). This is what Church is for: to help us in that walk, to encourage us, challenge us, sometimes to correct us, always to strengthen us and give us hope. The Church, lived in a very real way locally in a parish, like St. Joan of Arc, is meant to help each of us encounter the presence of Christ in ALL the experiences of life.

Football needs a team. Life needs relationships (love). Faith needs Church. As we dive deeper into 2026, let's all help each other love God with not half, not two quarters worth, but with ALL our hearts, minds, soul and strength. Let's help each other love each other as ourselves. This is what we were baptized for.



The Diocese encourages anyone with an allegation to also report that abuse to their local law enforcement agency. The Diocese reports all allegations received to the appropriate county prosecutor's office.




