GOSPEL

MATTHEW 4:12-23

When Jesus heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew to Galilee. He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali, that what had been said through Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled: Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali, the way to the sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles, the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light, on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death light has arisen. From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

As he was walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea; they were fishermen. He said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." At once they left their nets and followed him. He walked along from there and saw two other brothers, James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They were in a boat, with their father Zebedee, mending their nets. He called them, and immediately they left their boat and their father and followed him. He went around all of Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and curing every disease and illness among the people.

THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME / WORD OF GOD SUNDAY / 2026 **MUCH GOING ON**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

As I write this, there is talk of a big snowstorm coming this weekend. As you read this, you will know if this is true. So, though I don't know for sure what might be happening this weekend, I do know what will be happening:

On Saturday, following our School Open House we will open Catholic Schools Week at the 5:30pm Liturgy. We are so blessed to be a parish with a parish school! Our St. Joan of Arc School is staffed by excellent teachers and administered by an excellent principal, Sr. Pat Pycik. Because of our terrific PTA and the generosity of our parishioners, our school tuition is among the lowest in the state. I encourage you to consider offering your child a Catholic education, an education that is faith based, one that will help your child grow spiritually as well as academically and emotionally. Please call for an appointment and a tour of our School.

In the Catholic Church this Sunday is known as "Word of God Sunday." We take a Sunday early in the year to emphasize the importance of Sacred Scripture in our lives as disciples of Jesus Christ (who is God's Word made flesh!). Quite honestly, reading more Scripture should be on every Christian's New Year's Resolution List. We can all read it more and, indeed, pray it more. Every Sunday, like today, we have a "Smorgasburg of Scripture" laid before us: readings from the Old Testament, the Book of Psalms, St. Paul's Letters and the Gospel. Maybe during the week before Sunday, you can take some time to read the Gospel (or any of that Sunday's readings); let it lead you into prayer. This way you will be better prepared to enter into the Sunday Liturgy.

This Sunday also happens to fall on the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul. Conversion implies a radical turning, a complete change involving the mind and heart which is manifested in our attitude, our decisions, the words we speak and our actions. Conversion begins with a call from Christ to follow Him ... exactly what we hear in the Gospel this Sunday.

Hopefully everything we do here at St. Joan of Arc, beginning with Sunday Mass and including all of our ministries, programs and events for young and old alike (including our School and Religious Education Ministry), hopefully all of this helps each of us hear the Word of God more clearly in our lives and to follow where Christ leads and, strengthened by the Eucharist, to live as the Body of Christ, doing His work in the world.

There is a lot going on this weekend (maybe including a snowstorm). There is a lot of work to do in the world.
