



YOUR REAL ID

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Hopefully everyone is surviving the cold! We are all looking forward to an early spring ... let the groundhog be forewarned!

In today's Gospel, Jesus takes us up a mountain (hopefully not a snow-covered one). We begin His most famous Sermon, the one on the Mount, found in Matthew's Gospel, chapters five through seven. We will only get to hear a small portion of the Sermon this year because Lent begins relatively early (on the 18th).

The Sermon begins with the Beatitudes which, in effect, is a summary of the entire three chapters. Because in the Beatitudes Jesus gives us a new vision of God and God's Kingdom, we are also given a new way of living if we want to call ourselves disciples of Christ.

The other night, one of the members of our Liturgy Planning Team said that in the Beatitudes we find our "Real ID as Christians." We all know about Real IDs! (Did you get yours?)

The Beatitudes is a good intro also to the Season of Lent. Take some time this week to read through them slowly, maybe take one a day, beginning today. What does each say about God? What picture of God is Jesus painting for us through the Beatitudes? Then, of course, see if any of the Beatitudes speaks to you of your own experiences? Does one challenge you in a particular way? Can you hear the "upside-down-ness" of them? Finally, as you read them and pray with them, keep in mind, "Blessed" is also sometimes translated as "Happy," "Fortunate." What is Jesus' concept of happiness or joy?

SPIRIT AND MIND

Make your masterpiece! The use of art therapy has grown in recent years, and many studies have shown that it plays a significant role in alleviating depression symptoms and anxiety while supporting individuals with Alzheimer's and autism. So how exactly does it work? 

Dear Parishioners,


