SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT / 2026

Overwhelmed and oh so Grateful

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

How to describe the feelings of Peter, James and John as they experience Jesus transfigured before them, appearing with Moses and Elijah, in an "other-worldly" state, Jesus' face "shining like the sun," his clothes as "white as light"?

At first, in apparent joy, Peter wants to build three tents and stay right there on the mountain. Then, when the voice of God is heard, the disciples are in great fear; Jesus tells them not to be afraid. Coming down the mountain they ask Jesus questions which could mean they are confused or curious or hungering to know more about who He is.

"Overwhelmed" is a word that strikes me as accurate. The disciples are overwhelmed, in over their heads with joy, fear, bewilderment. Is it possible to feel all of these things at once?

At Mass, when I hear the Word of God, I can sometimes be filled with a certain amount of trepidation — call it fear, if you want — not knowing if I can ever live the way Jesus calls me too. Jesus says, "Follow me," and that alone can be a bit scary.

At the same time, during Mass, worshipping God with all of you, I can experience such a sense of joy and peace and comfort, praising God for His presence, receiving Christ in the Eucharist.

At the same time, while feeling so close to God, I can have many questions about the mystery of God. There is so much I do not understand. I love that the Gospel writers are honest and don't whitewash their own lack of understanding; makes me feel I am in good company.

At the same time, even overwhelmed by fear or joy or unknowing, or all three all at once, I can feel a deep and abiding sense of gratitude, gratitude for the gift of being alive, being loved, and being held in the presence of so great a Mystery.

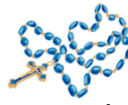

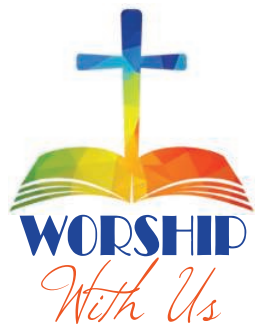
