## *Before and After Empathy*

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Recently I've read where some Christian preachers have railed against the "sin of empathy." They think too much empathy can turn us soft and weak-kneed when it comes to standing for the truth.

Never mind that I don't think we can ever have too much of it; it seems to me the opposite is true — there is never enough empathy.

Empathy is, to quote a dictionary, "the *action* of understanding, being aware of, being sensitive to, and vicariously experiencing the feelings, thoughts and experience of another." (Merriam-Webster.com; italics are mine). In other words, empathy involves involvement.

Before Jesus fed the multitudes of people, He recognized their presence, He understood what they might be feeling, and He moved into action.

In today's Gospel, Jesus who is tired and thirsty for water in the heat of the day, recognizes a different kind of thirst in a Samaritan woman by the well. In the midst of a conversation that no one has imagined ever having with her, while being truthful with her, Jesus helps her to recognize her own value. She exists and she is valuable.

Empathy takes work. It demands that we first notice people, really see them, hear them, let them speak and question. It demands we see people as people, not categories. The woman at the well fit into many categories. Woman. Foreigner. Enemy. Either divorced or widowed, certainly different. Jesus notices her and her thirsting heart. That's what empathy does.

As we heard in our Mission last week, in the Bible there are a lot of "before and after" stories. This is one of them. Before meeting Jesus the woman goes up to the well, thirsting, with an empty jug. After meeting Jesus she leaves the jug, her emptiness, and goes back into town, filled with living water, to tell the people about Jesus. "Could he be the Messiah?" she asks. She is not even 100% sure of it herself but even that can't stop her from living a new life with a new purpose with new hope.

That's what empathy can do. That's what a relationship with Jesus Christ — God *with* us — can do, too. I think we need more of both in our lives and in our world.

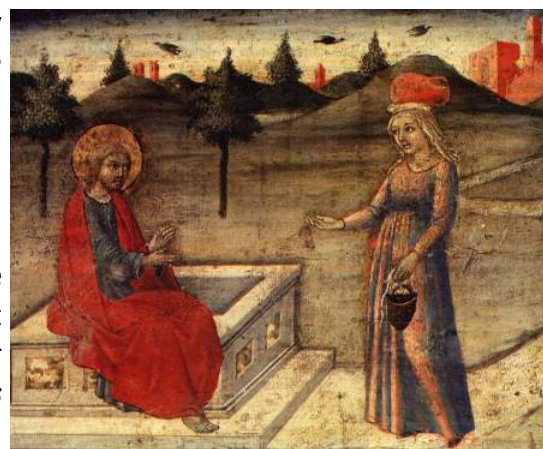
Maybe it sounds too pedestrian, too ordinary, too mundane to say Jesus was a good listener?

The encounter between Jesus and the Samaritan woman at the well has so many deep and significant theological points. It has much to say about conversion and about who Jesus Christ is as Messiah and Savior.

The woman is so moved, so filled with faith and perhaps even love for Jesus, even without completely understanding who He is, she goes down to the town and begins to evangelize, to tell others about this Jesus.

But what gets the ball rolling is Jesus, tired and thirsty, sits down to talk to her, a woman, a foreign woman, a many-times married woman which could be scandalous or very tragic, depending on the circumstances, but either way, Jesus can see something: she is thirsty, too.

Jesus is able to engage in conversation with her **because before all else He sees her ...** not as a sinner, not as a stranger or enemy, but **as a person who has value.**

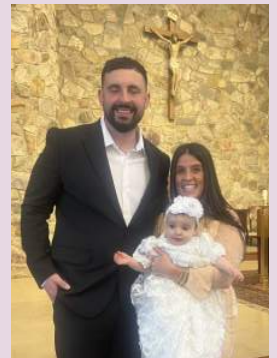

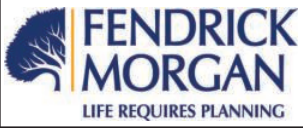

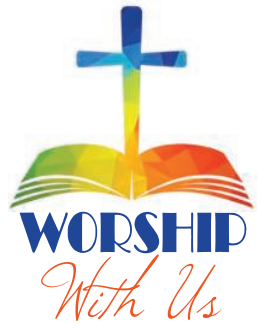
