Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We have reached week four of our journey through Lent to Easter. How is it going? How is God “bringing to perfection within you the image of Jesus Christ”? This is the ultimate goal of Lent, the ultimate goal of discipleship. Hopefully focusing on the attributes and characteristics of Jesus are helping you to do this.

Today's attribute for our focus is Jesus as Healer. Think of all that “healing” implies. Physical healing, for one, but not always. Many times in the Gospel, the healing miracles are more a sign pointing to Jesus' divinity, His union with God the Father. In fact, in the Gospel of John, miracles are called “signs.” Even in our Gospel today (another long one!), the debate on Jesus' identity is the focus, much more than the actual healing of a blind man. The leaders of the people have a difficult time believing Jesus is from God. They have a pre-set idea about what the Messiah should look like. Maybe we do, too.

All of this is a long way of saying I think Jesus wants to heal our vision of God, our understanding of God, as much as curing our physical infirmities. We too often limit God's love and mercy. We can think of God as giving crosses rather than helping us to carry them (i.e. “God will never dump more on us than we can carry”). We sometimes confuse God with Zeus or Santa Claus or Superman. I think Jesus wants to “heal” our faith by revealing God as the loving creator and sustainer of life who walks with us, suffers with us, who gives up power and control, who becomes one with us to save us from ourselves.

We can be our own worst enemies. Jesus wants to heal us, give us new sight, a new way of seeing not only God but also ourselves and one another.

How is Jesus “healing” your faith?

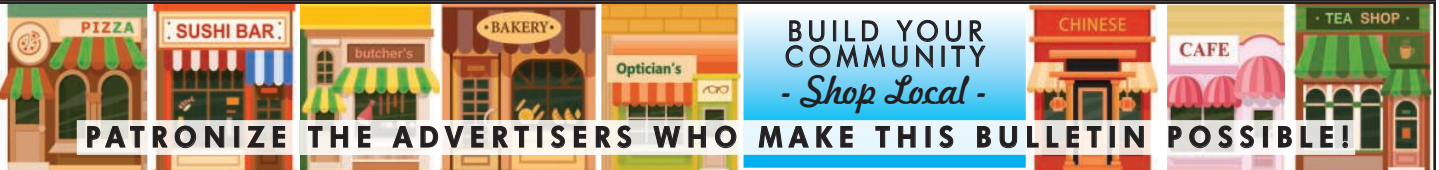
