PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION/ 2026 *To the Cross and Beyond*

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This is our moment. The Church's moment before the Cross. All around the world today Christians follow Jesus to the cross. Today is not just a day on the calendar. It's not just a "today in history" kind of thing. While we recall the events of Jesus Christ's passion (suffering) and death, we do not stay in the past with it. Today is our day to make a decision.

Do we follow Jesus to the cross? Do we drink from the cup He drinks (a question He asked His first disciples)? Are we all in or not?

Let's follow Jesus. Let's make His **truth** about God, our truth. Let's make His **way** of living and loving our way. Let's make His **life** within us the source of our life, our purpose, our mission.

I encourage you to make the most of this Holy Week. Live it intentionally and differently from all others. If you can participate in the Holy Week and Easter Triduum liturgies, I urge you to do so. Joining the community in prayer and worship on Holy Thursday and Good Friday, especially, will enrich your Easter celebration in profound ways.

Please also pray for the women and men entering into the Church at the Easter Vigil. These are 26 adults who made the decision to be baptized or enter the Catholic Church. It was a conscious, purposeful decision. Hopefully they will inspire all of us to do the same: to consciously live as Christ every day.

On behalf of Fr. JM, Deacons Gene and Barry, the Sisters of St. Joseph, and the entire Parish Staff, we wish you a blessed Holy Week.

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Everyone has a defining moment, a moment when others see clearly who that person is, what that person stands for, what that person believes. On Palm Sunday, we remember and celebrate Jesus' "moment." Last Tuesday, in our reading from John's Gospel, Jesus told the people: *“When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will realize that I AM.”* Lifted up on the cross, we will know who Jesus is.

While kneeling on holy ground before the burning bush, Moses asked God, “What is your name?” Bold question, but Moses needed to know it if He was going to persuade Pharaoh to free the slaves. God replies: **“I AM WHO AM.”** If I could be so bold, I'd like to say that that was God's defining moment in the Hebrew Scriptures. God reveals Himself as the Holy Ground of Being, Ultimate Reality, Infinite Horizon.

Jesus says this is when we will recognize Him as **I AM**, as the Son of God, as God, on the cross, at His most vulnerable, when He gives His life. It is important for us to know this about Him, just as it was so important for Moses to know the name of God.

I AM WHO AM. I AM WITH YOU. We see this most visibly on the cross. All Lent long we have been praying that we would be more like Christ in our daily living. We have been praying that God “might perfect the image of Christ within us.” How do we bring Jesus' vulnerability, His letting go of power and control, how do we bring this to our daily living?

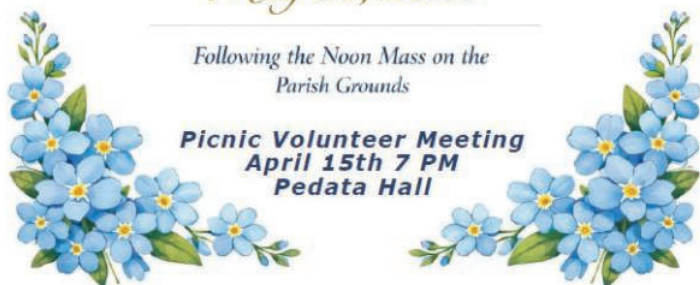
