PASCHAL CANDLE

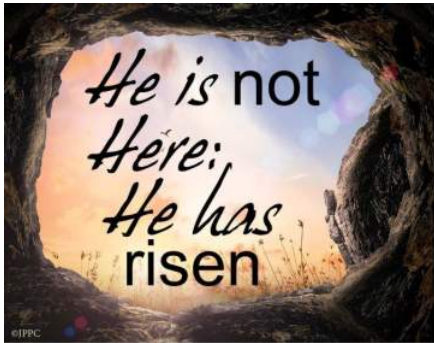

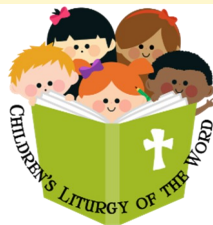

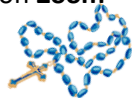

LOVE IN ACTION: Justice Corner



April 12th - April 20th Hygiene Supply Collection for JOSEPH'S HOUSE OF CAMDEN

April 30th, 7 PM - "Blessing Bag" Assembly, Pedata Hall

Love in Action ministry will be collecting hygiene supplies to benefit Joseph's House of Camden.

Joseph's House is a low-barrier overnight shelter for unhoused adult men and women that provides hot meals, a shower, laundry facilities, hygiene supplies, and access to dedicated case workers that help move people from homelessness to housing.
