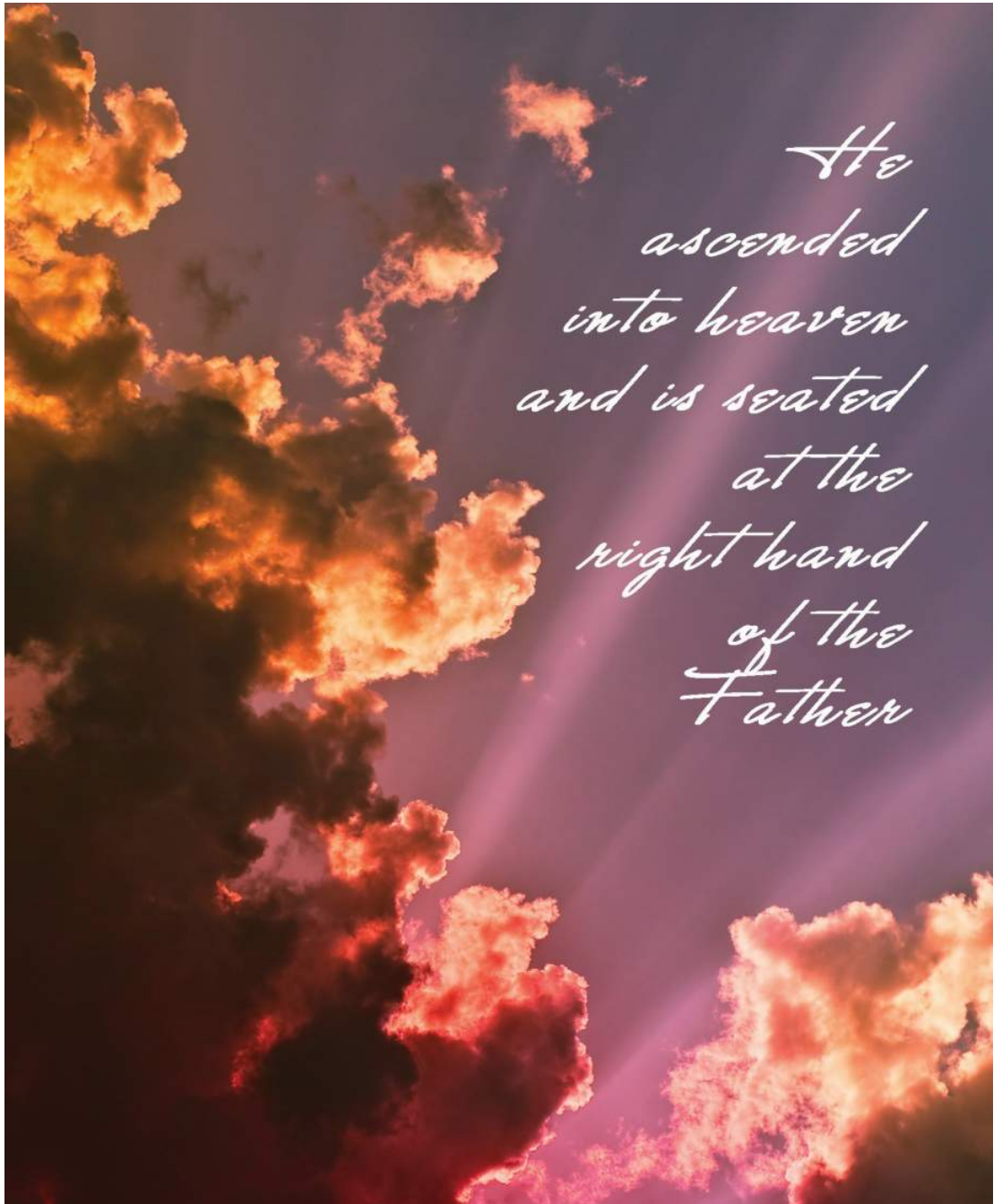

## ASCENSION OF THE LORD/2026 GATEWAY TO PENTECOST, TO TODAY

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

At the risk of being repetitious, some 6 years ago or so the Bishops of New Jersey exercised the right given to them by the Church to move the Holy Day called the Ascension of the Lord Jesus Christ from a Thursday to a Sunday. We could spend a lot of time debating the change; lots of people still tell me they liked it better on Thursday, forty days after Easter, "like it says in the Bible." Except that only St. Luke mentions the forty day period in the Acts of the Apostles. Matthew, Mark and John chose not to give us an exact time frame. All of them, however, tell us that Jesus returned to the Father, that the Resurrected Christ is the Glorified Christ, seated at the right hand of the Father.

What seems more important than when we celebrate it, is that this important event, Christ's return to the Father, is the gateway to the giving of the Holy Spirit, an event we celebrate on Pentecost.

In ascending to the Father, Jesus Christ gives His disciples a mission: to make disciples, to baptize, to teach the baptized everything He taught them ("love one another the way I love have loved you").

Then, Jesus promises to be with them (us) always. That's the Holy Spirit! Without the Holy Spirit, we cannot fulfill that mission. It is the power and inspiration of the Spirit that unites us and empowers us to do all that Jesus did.

The Ascension and Pentecost, together, gives us a great opportunity to reflect on our mission as a disciple of Christ. Do you think of yourself as a disciple before anything else? How are you helping to make other disciples? How are you teaching what Jesus taught (through word and action, by the way we live our lives)?

In my opinion, the last thing Jesus would want us to do is quibble about how many days there are between Easter and the Ascension. He'd want us to use all our energy to do the work He has given us to do right now, today.

*Keep Easter Going!*

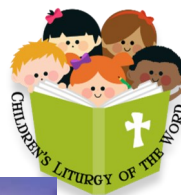

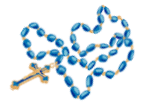

### DID YOU KNOW?

May 15 marked the 135th anniversary of Pope Leo XIII's encyclical *Rerum Novarum*, which is considered the foundation of Catholic Social Doctrine and is especially relevant in today's economic and political moment when human dignity is often pushed aside for the sake of profit and power. *Rerum Novarum* was written in 1891, a time of historic economic change that brought dramatic wealth inequality. Pope Leo XIII stated that public authorities should protect the rights of the poor and vulnerable, and advocated for the right to private property, formation of unions, fair wages, limited work hours, and special protections for vulnerable workers. *Rerum Novarum* also articulated the right of the Church to speak out on social matters and its responsibility to educate people so that they act justly and uphold human dignity.

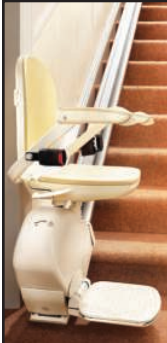
