Pentecost/2026 INTO DEEPER UNITY

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

What is your relationship with the Holy Spirit? How do you think of the Holy Spirit moving in your life? Have you ever asked the Spirit for guidance, for courage, to help you to pray?

When we celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation the words prayed over us are: "Send your Holy Spirit upon them to be their helper and guide. Give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of right judgement and courage, the spirit of knowledge and reverence. Fill them with the spirit of wonder and awe in your presence." We call these the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. You have them!

The Holy Spirit is God's presence within us, working within us, always moving us into a deeper relationship, a deeper union with the truth of God's presence and love. The Holy Spirit opens our eyes to recognize God and God's truth. The Holy Spirit opens our ears to hear God's Word, God's call to love, to serve, to do what is right. The Holy Spirit opens our hearts to receive God's love and to love one another as Jesus Christ loves. The Holy Spirit strengthens us to forgive, to trust, to care. The Holy Spirit opens our arms to do the daily work of healing and reconciliation.

It is no accident that when the apostles receive the Holy Spirit, as we hear in our Gospel on Easter Sunday night, and also in the Acts of the Apostles (our first reading), fifty days later, they are gathered together, all of them, in one place. The Spirit moves within each one of us but the Spirit always moves all of us into a deeper communion with God and one another.

The Christian life, the life of discipleship, following Jesus, is not meant to be done alone. This is exactly why we celebrate the beginning of the Church on Pentecost, on this Feast of the Holy Spirit.

Ironically, as we celebrate the anniversary of our independence this year, this Sesquicentennial is really a celebration of our 250th Year together as **one** nation. Those we remember this Memorial Day Weekend gave their lives not for their own ambition, not for their own self-interest or glory, not for their own political agenda, but for something larger and greater than themselves. We can honor these fallen heroes best by deepening our bonds of unity, by being courageous in our resolve, our commitment to serve what is good for all of us, which in the words of Jesus always means caring for the least of us. This is what the Holy Spirit is always leading, inspiring, guiding, helping us to do.

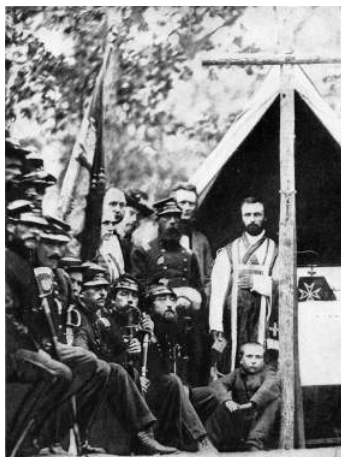

Fr. William Corby, above, a Catholic priest and chaplain during the Civil War, stood upon a rock and prayed for and gave general absolution to the soldiers of the Irish Brigade who were about to enter the Wheat Field during the Battle of Gettysburg on July 2, 1863. A statue marks the spot and honors the event. Many of the men who received absolution were killed that day fighting for the end of slavery. As President Lincoln would later say, these men, in sacrificing their lives, hallowed the ground upon which they died. During the Civil War, approximately 200,000 Catholics served in the Union army, about 10% of the total force. 4,000 men in the Irish Brigade lost their lives during the war, fighting at Gettysburg, Antietam, and many other major battles in the war.
