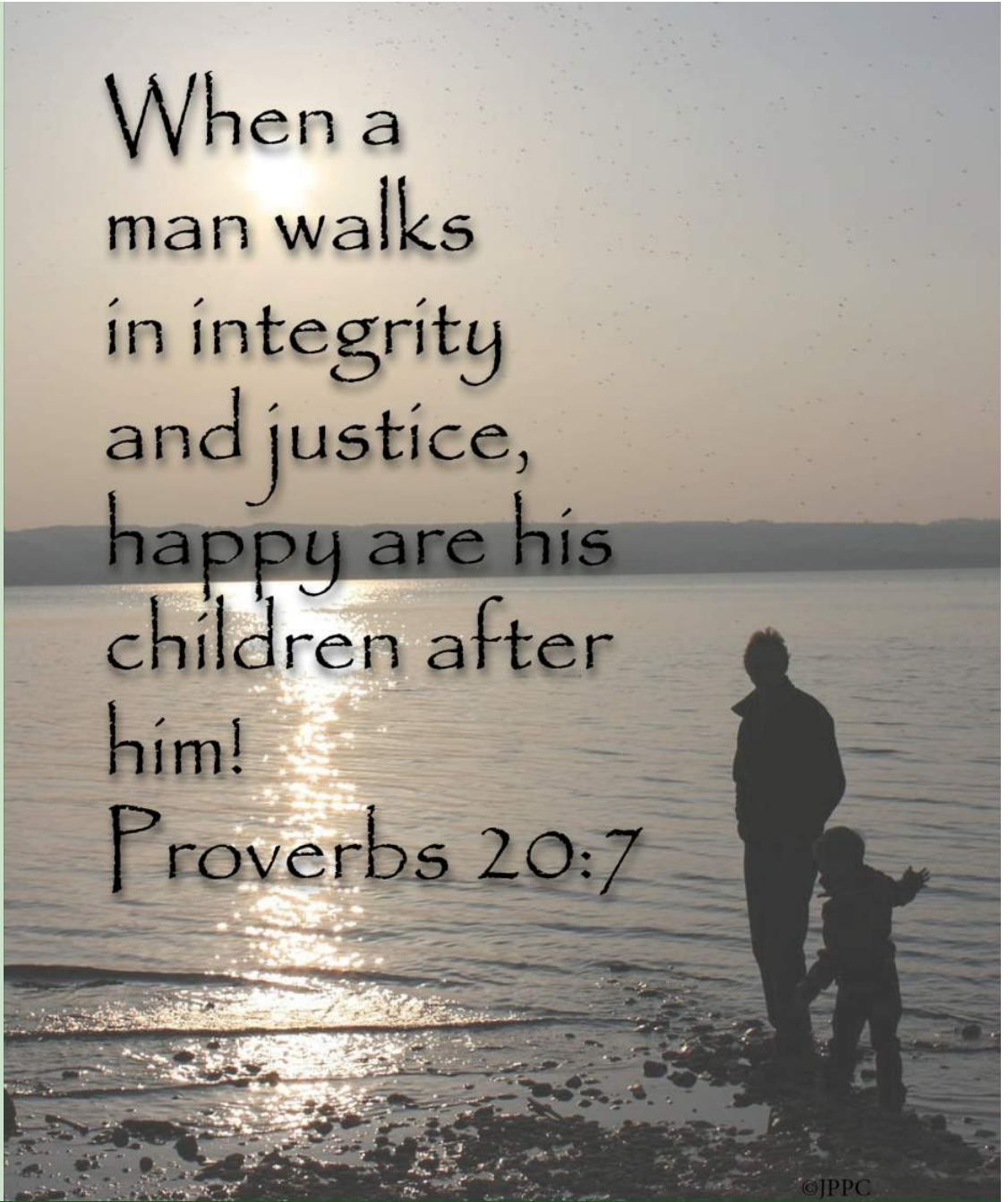

TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME/ 2026 WHO KNOWS YOU?

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Jesus says God knows how many hairs are on our head (as I get older, there isn't as much to count!) But the point is, God knows us. God knows us better than anyone else. And in knowing us, God loves us. To illustrate and drive home this message, Jesus calls God Abba, the Aramaic word for "daddy." His relationship with the Creator is that personal, that intimate. "The Father and I are one," Jesus says in John's Gospel. And, just as He and the Father are one, so are we one with Christ.

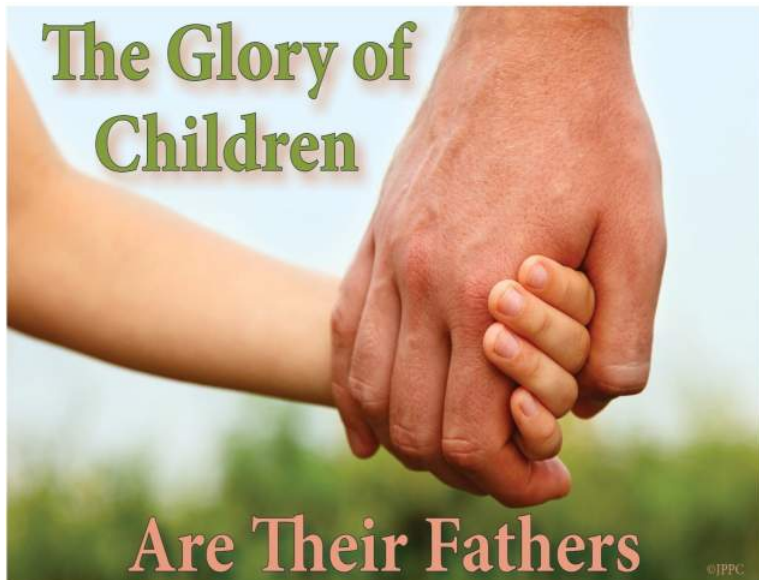
We are known and loved. By God. Abba. Who wants us to know and love Him.

Catholic in America



Many cities were named for a Saint or another aspect of our Catholic faith; at least two are named after the Eucharist. We listed a few examples here. Can you think of others?

On August 28, 1565, Spanish explorer Pedro Menendez d Aviles sighted land. He named the spot not after himself, but after Saint Augustine whose feast day it was. Today, a large cross in St. Augustine, Florida marks the place where the explorers celebrated a Mass of Thanksgiving, perhaps the first Mass in what would become the USA ... perhaps America's first Thanksgiving.



According to its website, **CORPUS CHRISTI**, Texas, was named by "Spanish explorer Alonzo Alvarez de Pineda in 1519, on the Roman Catholic Feast Day of Corpus Christi. The bay, and the City that later

sprung up there, took the name of the feast day celebrating the 'Body of Christ.'" It was in 1829 that the first known permanent settlement of Corpus Christi was established.



ST. PAUL, MINNESOTA. In 1841, missionary Fr. Lucien Galtier built a chapel he named for St. Paul on a bluff in a settlement called by the locals "Pig's Eye." Fr. Galtier insisted the settlement be given the same name as the chapel. The Minnesota

Territory was created in 1849 with Saint Paul as the capital. The small chapel, which reminded Fr. Galtier of the stable Jesus was born in, became the first cathedral for the new diocese of St. Paul.

Did you know its original name was *La Villa Real de la Santa Fe de San Francisco de Asís* (Royal Town of the Holy Faith of Saint Francis of Assisi). It's a bit of a mouthful, so now it's called **SANTA FE** ... a town literally with "faith" in its name. It is home to what is regarded as the oldest church structure in America (1610), San Miguel Chapel (pictured here).



The San Antonio Spurs hail from the seventh most populous city in the USA, the second largest in Texas. The area was named in

1691 by a Spanish expedition in honor of St. Anthony of Padua, the patron saint many of us call upon when we lose our keys. Perhaps the Spurs will call upon him to find a basketball championship next year!

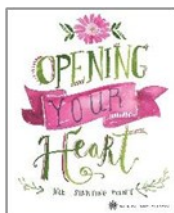

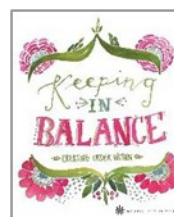

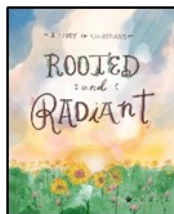
We meet on Wednesday's with three sessions available at 6:30a, 10a 7p.



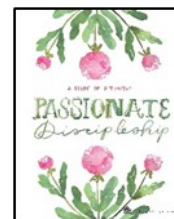
