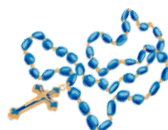

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

Please pray for all those who have begun new pastoral assignments, including Fr. Gregory Abadilla, the new pastor of St. Mary of the Lakes in Medford.

By the time you read this letter, hopefully it will have cooled off a bit ... but just a bit. Let's keep summer around for as long as we can!

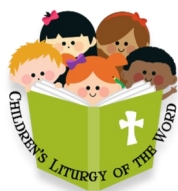

Religious Education for 2026-2027 -

We are beginning to prepare for the fall! In order to meet the various faith formation needs of our children and their families, we offer multiple options in our program:

Weekly/Traditional Program (Grades 1–8): Classes meet Mondays or Tuesdays from 5:15–6:30 PM.

Family Program (1st Grade): Four Sunday sessions throughout the year, with parent participation and at-home activities.

Special Disciples: Faith formation and sacramental preparation for children with special needs, meeting approximately twice monthly on Sundays.

Home Study (Grades 3–6): Parent-led instruction at home following a syllabus provided by the Religious Education Office, with required activity participation.

OCIA Tweens/Teens: For children who missed prior years of Religious Education, and need foundational catechesis and sacramental preparation. Placement and scheduling are arranged through the Religious Education Office.

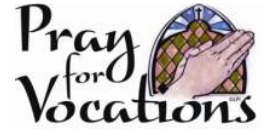

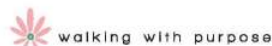

MARY STATUE HOME VISIT

Are you ready to be blessed?

Host Mary in your home.

St. Joan of Arc families have the **wonderful opportunity** to sign up to host the traveling statue of Mary (Our Lady of Fatima) in your home. The sign-up sheet is located in the Church's Gathering/Cry Room. Those who are interested simply sign up for a **one-week time slot** (Sunday to Sunday). While the statue visits your home, you are encouraged to pray and say the rosary daily with her. By hosting the Blessed Mother statue in your home, you may **receive abundant graces** from her visit. Our Lady, through the rosary, always brings us closer to her son, Jesus Christ.



What is involved with a Mary Statue home visit?

1. You create a special place in your home for the statue.
2. Place a decorative table cover, candles or vigil light, flowers and other desired objects to create a special area for the Blessed Mother.
3. Bring the Blessed Mother (as symbolized by the Our Lady of Fatima statue) into your home with love and reverence.
4. The statue is placed at her shrine that you've created for the week.
5. Family and friends gather around their heavenly Mother and pray.

What is included?

1. The statue is housed in a rolling travel case that is padded for her protection
2. A guidebook with suggested prayers to follow during her visit
3. A rosary (to use in case you don't have your own)

Timing

Sign-up on the sign-up sheet. When it is your week, you simply **pick up** the Mary Statue in its rolling travel case at **11 am (on Sunday)** from the Church Gathering/Cry Room.

You will host the statue at your house until the following Sunday. It needs to be returned to the Gathering/Cry Room no later than 10:30 am the following Sunday so that the next parishioners can pick it up for their turn.

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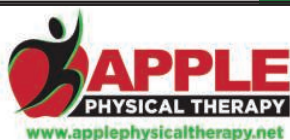
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
