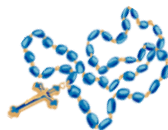

### Religious Education for 2026-2027 -

We are beginning to prepare for the fall! In order to meet the various faith formation needs of our children and their families, we offer multiple options in our program:

**Weekly/Traditional Program (Grades 1–8):** Classes meet Mondays or Tuesdays from 5:15–6:30 PM.

**Family Program (1st Grade):** Four Sunday sessions throughout the year, with parent participation and at-home activities.

**Special Disciples:** Faith formation and sacramental preparation for children with special needs, meeting approximately twice monthly on Sundays.

**Home Study (Grades 3–6):** Parent-led instruction at home following a syllabus provided by the Religious Education Office, with required activity participation.

**OCIA Tweens/Teens:** For children who missed prior years of Religious Education, and need foundational catechesis and sacramental preparation. Placement and scheduling are arranged through the Religious Education Office.

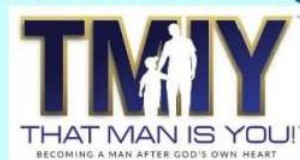

### LOVE IN ACTION: Life, Justice and Creation

#### Did you know?

There are 7 themes of Catholic Social Teaching. The first one is **LIFE AND DIGNITY OF THE HUMAN PERSON**: The Catholic Church states that human life is sacred from conception to natural death, because we all bear the image of God. Dignity of each and every person is the framework for a moral society, and is a God-given attribute that is not determined by our actions, nor can it be taken away. This belief is the foundation of all the principals of our social teaching. The Church works to ensure that every person can live in circumstances that promote their innate dignity.

Catholic "social justice" is the same as Catholic Social Teaching. It is not a political movement. The Catechism of the Catholic Church calls social justice "the respect for the human person, and the rights which flow from human dignity and guarantee it." As Catholics, we work for social justice by promoting human dignity in many ways. Keep your eye on the bulletin in the coming weeks as we highlight different individuals and organizations that live Catholic Social Teaching by promoting human dignity.

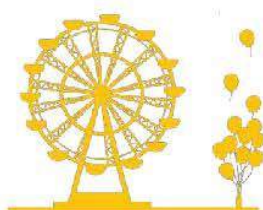

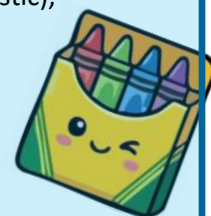

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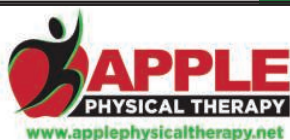
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
