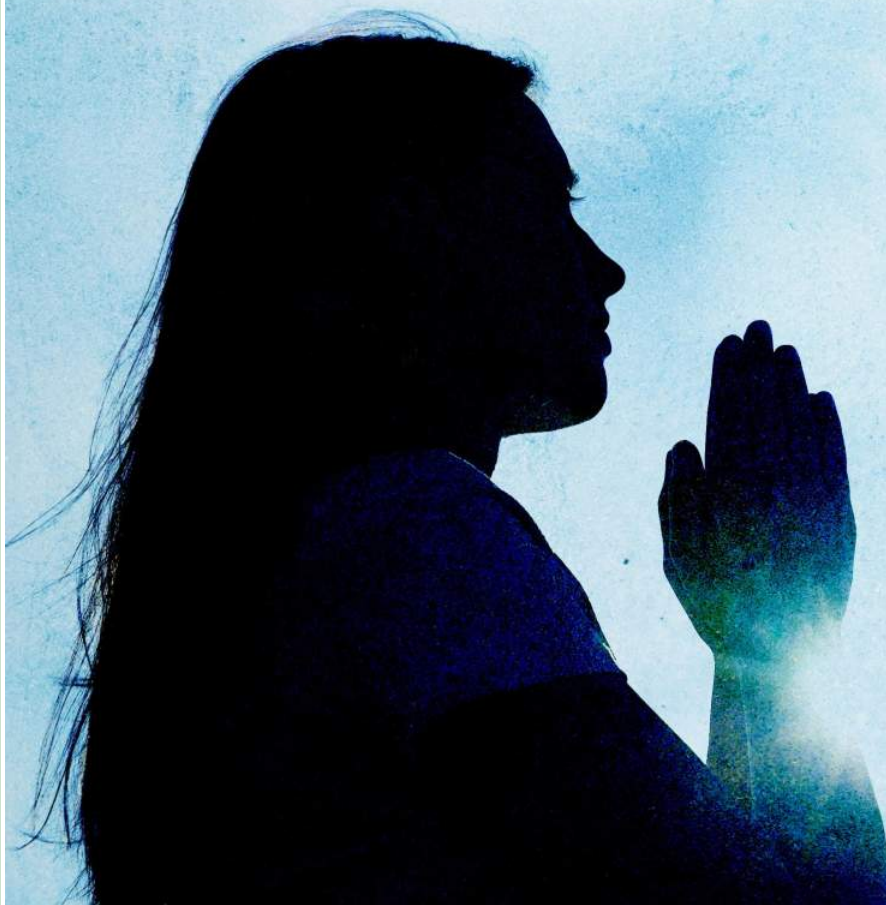

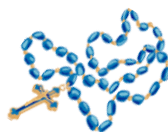

"GREAT FAITH"

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In Matthew's Gospel, only twice does Jesus say of someone that they have "great faith." Only twice. Nope, He doesn't say it of Peter (last week, in fact, Jesus said Peter had "little faith" ... yikes!). Not Andrew, James or John either. None of the twelve, actually, get so praised by Jesus.

It is a Roman Centurian in chapter 8, and the woman we hear about in today's Gospel (chapter 15), a Canaanite woman. We do not know either of their names. Neither is Jewish; both are Gentiles, foreigners. Jesus says of the first that He has found no one in Israel with such "great faith" that this Centurian has. And to the latter, Jesus says: "O woman, great is your faith!"

What does the Centurian and the Canaanite woman do to receive such lauds from Jesus?

The Centurian is a person who trusts in a big way. You don't even need to come into my house, he says to Jesus. Just say the word and I know my servant will be healed. He trusts in Jesus' word. Completely.

The Canaanite woman cries out on behalf of her tormented daughter. Though the disciples of Jesus try to send her away, she persists in her calling to Jesus. So strong is her belief in the super-abundance of God's love and mercy, nothing will deter her.

Though Matthew does not tell us, surely this encounter with Christ changed these two people in a dramatic way. Their "great faith" truly must have moved them to "love greatly." This is what great faith, this is what meeting Jesus, always does.

Religious Education for 2026-2027 -

We are beginning to prepare for the fall! In order to meet the various faith formation needs of our children and their families, we offer multiple options in our program:

Weekly/Traditional Program (Grades 1–8): Classes meet Mondays or Tuesdays from 5:15–6:30 PM.

Family Program (1st Grade): Four Sunday sessions throughout the year, with parent participation and at-home activities.

Special Disciples: Faith formation and sacramental preparation for children with special needs, meeting approximately twice monthly on Sundays.

Home Study (Grades 3–6): Parent-led instruction at home following a syllabus provided by the Religious Education Office, with required activity participation.

OCIA Tweens/Teens: For children who missed prior years of Religious Education, and need foundational catechesis and sacramental preparation. Placement and scheduling are arranged through the Religious Education Office.
