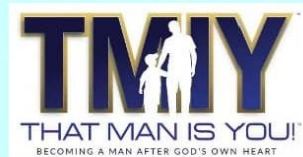

I hope many friends will join us. It would be great to see you.



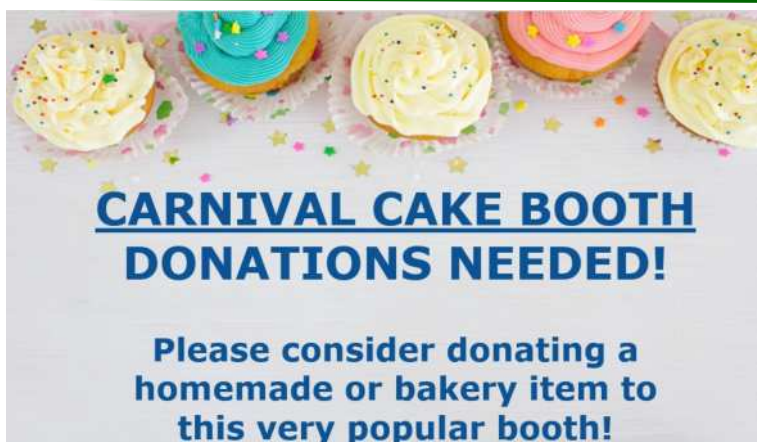
Could Your Spare Room Change a Life?

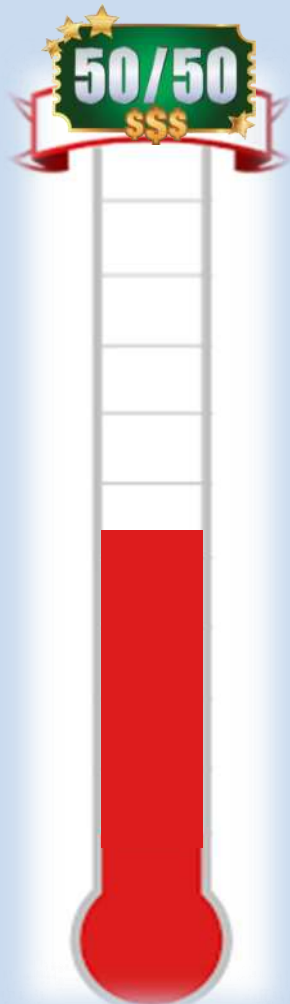

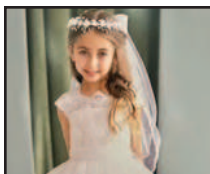
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
